Air Conditioning Update

It is now May, and we are in the middle of our fundraising campaign to help defray some of the **\$26,000** cost for the new air conditioners for our Fellowship Hall, Adult Lounge and senior high room. The units have been installed and we can now look forward to using those areas without being "cooked out" by the summer heat.

We currently have raised just over **\$4,000** towards this cost. Over the past several years we have put off replacing certain improvements but felt the air conditioning was critical in keeping our facility comfortable to use. This cost is over and above our normal church operating costs.

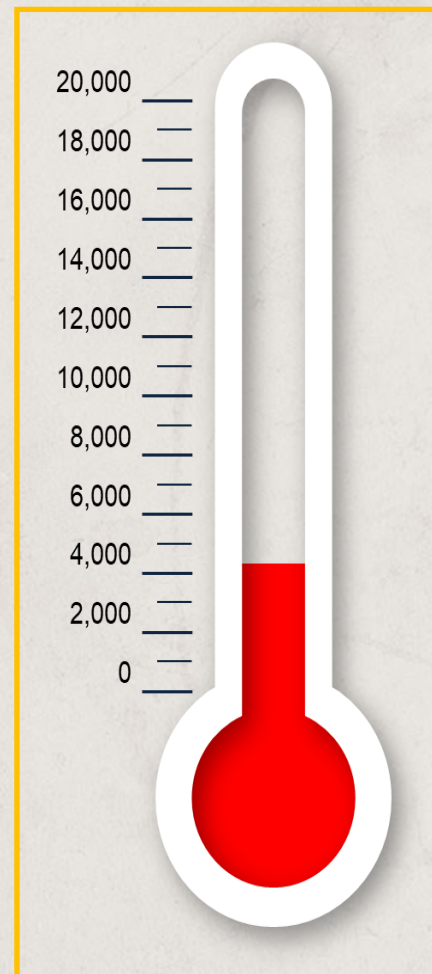

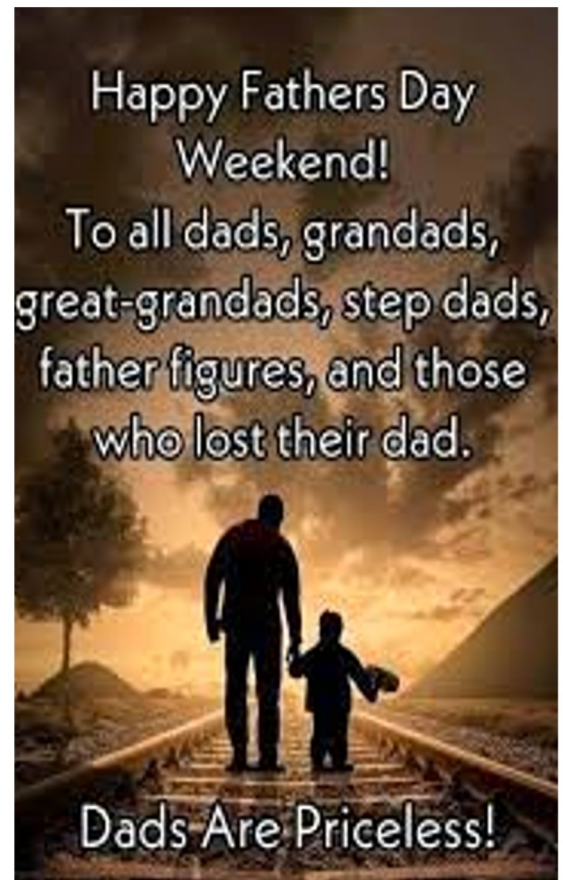

Outreach To Our Neighbors And Ukraine Refugees

I've been blessed this month to see God's handiwork in our missions and I'd like to share that with you.

Firstly, half of the revenues from the rummage sale were directed to Missions. These funds weren't earmarked for any particular mission but not by coincidence, the Midwest Mission Distribution Center put out an appeal for volunteers to assemble meal packets for the Ukrainian refugees and requested monetary donations for the supplies. Every dollar donated provided six meals. **Bethany's rummage sale resulted in \$600 for missions and that translated to 3,600 meals and that was our part (actually your part) of the 48,000 meals that shipped out from MMDC's leading dock last week. God is good!**

Secondly, Mary and I volunteer to help make and serve the monthly (second Saturday of the month) luncheon meal at the NEW Shelter. The regular meal we provide is grilled cheese sandwiches and tomato soup but this week, soup was out and pork & beans were in. We made our usual number of sandwiches, provided the regular number of bananas, potato chips, pickles and desert treats. Nothing out of the ordinary except for the line of folks to be fed that just kept coming.

In addition to those we served, we also provided @ 100 meals to go. Here's the remarkable. The last man to be served arrived just as the line was closing and he received: the last sandwich, the last banana, the last two pickles, and the last cupcake desert. I've never seen that happen before but it sure had a loaves and fishes feeling to it.

Lastly, in talking with the shelter's meal director we

learned that with the seasonal closing of St. John's Homeless Shelter as well as some cut backs in school lunch programs, they're now feeding around 300 suppers nightly.

New Community Shelter is the Mission Outreach for June & July

Rightly so then, we're designating the NEW Shelter as our monthly mission for both June and July. Your financial gifts will help ease the burden for the additional meals in July and August.
