### **Bethany Financial Information 2022**

### **Dear Bethany Supporters**

The following is a summary of our annual 2022 Operating Budget. Some items of note are as follows:

- 1. We will have some increases in our Staff budget now that we are "kind of" out of co-vid times and have normal staffing.
- 2. In addition, we have a new 2<sup>nd</sup> service worship position for 2022 that we are excited to add to our Music ministry.
- 3.We do have a few improvements to our church property that will be necessary this year that is included in the Trustees budget. These improvements are:
  - a. Gutter for Fellowship Hall
  - b. Tree Removal
  - c. Fire Safety Door Replacement
  - d. Two baseboard heaters in senior high room plus adding two 20 amp circuits in the Kitchen

The new air conditioning for the Fellowship Hall and Adult Lounge is not included in this Operating Budget. That amount, \$24,00 will require special funding such as a special fund drive which you will be hearing more about soon.



### **Bethany CAT Survey Results Summary**

THANK YOU to the 121 people who participated in the Congregational Assessment Tool Survey. We are truly blessed to be surrounded by so many people who care for the health and vitality of our ministry here at Bethany. We had a fantastic turnout on April 3<sup>rd</sup> where we heard the results of our survey.

You shared that our top three priorities where we should spend additional energy to improve our ministries:

- Make necessary changes to attract families with children and youth to our church.
- Develop and implement a comprehensive strategy to reach new people and incorporate them into the life of church.
- Develop ministries that work toward healing those broken by life circumstances.

Based on the results of the survey the Ad Board identified action items for next steps and has decided to start with the following:

- 1) **Evaluate Worship & Music:** You have said that the current worship and music needs improvement. Jamie Luepke and the Worship Committee will be leading a series of listening sessions to hear your ideas for improving the worship experience. These sessions are taking place in early May. Please take an opportunity to be part of the conversations, as everyone's ideas and thoughts should be heard. The Worship Committee will share the results of these sessions at the Quarterly meeting (Step #2) and together we will discern the next steps.
- 2) Leadership / Congregation Relationship: You are clearly saying in the CAT that how decisions are made is important, therefore gathering input, ideas and feedback is essential. The Ad Board will be organizing quarterly congregational meetings to share the good things that are happening, report on what various committees in the church have been working on, and most importantly listening to everyone regarding any questions or concerns. The first quarterly meeting will be held on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>June 5<sup>th</sup></u>. Details are still under development.

The following items will be developed over the course of the next year. The Ad Board does not have any details regarding who, how, when these will be addressed as the focus is on Steps 1 and 2 for the next few months. As each of these items come into focus the details will be shared.

- 3) **Deepen Relationships:** Bethany has gained new members and friends over the last three years in spite of a pandemic! The survey said there is a desire to facilitate connecting new members into the life and ministry of the church, creating a relationship among all members.
- 4) **Size Transition & Expectations:** Based on our responses, there are differing opinions about what people expect from the church. The Ad Board will be exploring this further with the assistance of an outside resource with expertise on Congregational Size Theory.
- 5) **Need for increased congregational care:** Based on our responses there is a need to help the congregation understand how spiritual caregiving is done, by whom, and why. This will be incorporate into the work done with point #4.
- 6) **Mission, Vision, Values, & Discipleship Pathways:** You are clearly saying that the church needs to be clear on its purpose and direction. Bethany needs to revisit our mission, vision, values and discipleship pathway.

Finally, in the survey you are saying that how you feel about our church is tied to how you feel about our Pastor and our leadership. To improve energy and satisfaction we need to celebrate wins frequently!

The CAT survey demonstrates that Bethany is in a great position to go from good things to great things. We are continuing to grow in faith with God and each other. We continue to strive to be faithful followers of Christ. Together we are the church.

# UMCOR is helping Ukraine Churches and Refugees

UMCOR funds are assisting local community shelters in Zaporizhzhia in Southeastern Ukraine and in and Mukachevo and Uzhhorod in Western Ukraine. The United Methodist Ukraine-Moldova Annual Conference is drawing on UMCOR in its support of the basic human needs of people on the move. Shelters exist in cities including Kyiv, Lviv, Kamyanitsia and Uzhhorod.

Initial UMCOR operational grants are assisting the efforts of United Methodists in Poland, Hungary, Slovakia and Romania to welcome and care for the refugees.

The United Methodist Church in Estonia will use an UMCOR grant to refit a camp site to house and provide emergency services to 40 refugees. As of March 30, an estimated 22,000 refugees from Ukraine had made their way into Estonia. Two camps related to The United Methodist Church in the Czech Republic are also being equipped with an UMCOR grant to house refugees. (Information from UMCOR.org)
