

Hurricane Ida update from their website: Food banks in Baton Rogue and New Orleans have been damaged by the hurricane, but remain open and serving their communities. Other food banks across Louisiana are assessing the needs of their pantries and food programs and are beginning to provide support to the hardest-hit areas.

Meanwhile, Feeding America has deployed 26 truckloads of food – about 970,000 pounds of food, water and other relief supplies, to the impacted communities. And, Feeding America has been working with Louisiana food banks since last week to coordinate disaster response to ensure food is available to people facing hunger in the wake of the storm.
