THE CHILDREN'S MESSAGE AND CHILDREN'S CHURCH (10:30 Service only) After the Gospel Reading, children are invited to come up to the front of the altar for a short children's message. Following this message, children may attend a class downstairs with age appropriate activities ranging from singing, Bible stories, and crafts to short Bible lessons. We have two different age groups to better accommodate the needs of our children: 2 - 5 year olds; K - 2nd graders. Children are ushered downstairs to the classrooms and back upstairs to join their families when the sermon is done. You may accompany your child if you wish. We hope you will also prayerfully consider volunteering to help out with this valuable ministry.

CHILDRENS BUSY BAGS are available for younger children as you are entering the worship center.

THE LORD'S SUPPER is the precious gift of Christ Himself. We celebrate it the second and fourth Sundays of each month in our 8am service and the first and third Sundays of each month in our 10:30am service. Jesus says to celebrate this supper, "Do this in remembrance of me." He also took bread and wine and said, "**This is my body..., this is my blood for you....**". Jesus gave up his life on the cross to forgive our sins. In this supper, Jesus is God's gift to us. He is the lamb of God who is this very meal. Christ joins us in this meal, unites us with himself. We proclaim his death and resurrection until he comes again. Therefore, we are saved by grace through faith in Christ's vicarious offering of Himself for us. (Ephesians 2:8-10). The Lord asks us to be united in faith and belief as we commune as one body. We welcome all who believe our confession to receive the Lord's Supper. God bless your communion.
