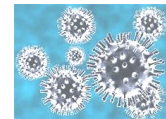

**To quote our District Superintendent:** This is an extraordinary event that requires us to respond in faith AND proactive leadership to protect the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made us overseers. We take these actions out of love for one another, not fear.

**In addition, we encourage each person to practice these general health precautions from the CDC:**

- Avoid sick individuals (or keep a minimum of 6 feet distance).
- Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds (recite the Lord's prayer) before eating, after coughing/sneezing and bathroom visits.
- Try not to touch the face, eyes, etc.
- Stay home if ill.
- Always look away and cover your sneeze.
- Disinfect frequently touched objects.

\*Until further notice, all Sunday & Wednesday services & meetings are cancelled. Most small group meetings are likely to be cancelled as well. Check with your leaders.

Reminder: Until otherwise notified by the civil authorities, no meetings greater than 10 people. Social distancing of 6 feet should be maintained.
