The Associate Pastor for Spiritual Formation and Community Life will serve as one of the pastors of The First Baptist Church of Redlands. This person, in cooperation and coordination with the Senior Pastor, Staff, the Christian Education Commission (and all other appropriate commissions), will administer, coordinate, resource, evaluate, and "grow" the Spiritual Formation programs and activities of the church. - the ability to connect with college students and people working in Higher Education.

- a Standard Ordination in the American Baptist Churches, USA, or a willingness to pursue such ordination.
