Galatians 3:11 - Clearly no one is justified before God by the law, because, "The righteous will live by faith."

2 Timothy 3:15 - How from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

2 Peter 1:21 - For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

John 17:17 – "Your word is truth."

Romans 1:16 - I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes.

Romans 3:22a-23 - There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Matthew 5:48 – "Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect."

Matthew 28:19,20 - Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

Psalms 51:5 - Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me.

Mark 16:16 “Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved.”

Titus 3:5 - He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit.

Romans 6:4 - We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
