LAW or GOSPEL?



Directions: In the following Scripture passages write law or gospel in the blank after each phrase or verse stating whether you think it is law or gospel.

Remember that in the Law God demands and blesses obedience, while punishing disobedience. The Gospel shows us God's free forgiveness, mercy, and promises in Christ.

Examples:

Luke 2:10-11 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord." GOSPEL

2 Samuel 12:13-14 Then David said to Nathan, "I have sinned against the LORD." LAW
Nathan replied, "The LORD has taken away your sin. You are not going to die. GOSPEL
But because by doing this you have made the enemies of the LORD show utter contempt, the son born to you will die." LAW

Jeremiah 31:34 No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the LORD. "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." _____

Romans 5:19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, _____ so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous. _____

Ezekiel 18:4 Every living soul belongs to me, the father as well as the son—both alike belong to me. The soul who sins is the one who will die. _____

Romans 3:21-24 But now a righteousness from God, apart from law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. _____ This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. _____ There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, _____ and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. _____

Exodus 34:6-7 And [the LORD] passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. _____ Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation." _____
