
Special Gifts Needed for Piano Fund or Chancel Furnishings:

Because our current piano is starting to show its age and is becoming less effective in accompanying choir and worship. The worship committee investigated several different options (new/used, electric/acoustic) and decided that a new classic grand piano would best suit our needs. We have a piano fund established, but approximately \$4900 more is needed to cover the purchase of the piano.

Initial rendering of the new altar, baptismal font, and lectern have been posted. The design committee hopes these will beautify the sanctuary and communicate the centrality of Word and Sacrament in our worship. We will be finalizing the details of these pieces in the coming weeks. The estimated cost of construction and shipping is \$13,000.

As we start a new year and a new decade, your Stewardship Committee would once again like to remind you of several special giving opportunities at Ascension:

- **Tuition Assistance Fund:** This fund is designed to support Ascension members who are attending Martin Luther College or Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary with the intent of becoming a teacher or pastor. Although we do not currently have any students studying for the public ministry, we invite to consider contributing so funds would be available for future workers from our congregation. You can designate special gifts to the "Tuition Assistance Fund".
- **Endowment Fund:** This fund was established to provide an alternate revenue stream that could be used to supplement special projects or programs not included in our regular budget. The Fund currently has \$30,000 in assets which is invested through WELS Investments. An additional \$55,000 donation will be arriving soon. Individuals often contribute assets to endowment funds in connection with wills and estate planning but cash donations may be made at any time. If you would like to contribute please direct your donation to the Endowment Fund or contact Dan Fischer.
- **Thrivent Choice Dollars:** If you have investments or insurance through Thrivent, you may be able to direct funds to the church or non-profit organization of your choice. Undesignated 2019 Choice Dollars expire on March 31, 2020. Go to Thrivent.com to check your Choice Dollar balance or designate funds. Please note that Ascension is listed under Minneapolis rather than Plymouth.

Lastly, we want to encourage all members to periodically review/revise their financial support of our congregation and synod especially for significant changes in income or expenses. Our congregation has historically been very blessed for which we give thanks to the Lord whose goodness and mercy endure forever.
