Request for Special Gifts to the Piano Fund: Our current piano has served our congregation well for many years, but is showing its age and is becoming less effective in accompanying choir and worship. Some of you may also be aware that Curt Putland gave a \$15,000 memorial to the piano fund in memory of his wife, Jayne. The worship committee has investigated several different piano options (new and used, electric and acoustic) and

decided that a new classic grand piano from Kawai--the GL-30--would best suit our worship space. The good people at Schmitt's Music are giving us a very generous discount (to the tune of \$6,000), but even with that discount, there is a difference of approx. \$4900 between what is currently in the piano fund and the price of the new piano. Should we gather excess funds, these monies will go towards new altar furnishings (altar, lectern, and baptismal font). **Hope Baures Adoption Update:** Most of you know that for several years now Greg and Melissa have been fighting to keep Hope as their adoptive daughter. Recently the judge in Wisconsin decided in favor of Hope staying with Greg and Melissa, but the biological father is again appealing the decision that it is in Hope's best interest to stay with her adoptive family.

Their legal fees for this multi-year litigation is currently at \$130,000 and rising. The emotional toll has been devastating, and they are struggling to provide for their family with this looming debt. Continue to keep the Baures family and Hope in particular in your prayers.
