SUMMARY

The purpose and role of the Pastor of Outreach at CBC is to lead, empower, and equip the CBC family in Reaching Out locally and globally.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Give oversight to Deacon and Deaconess Committee
- Oversee Outreach Ministries including GriefShare, DivorceCare, Car Care, Clothing Bank, and Food Bank, and see that these ministries serve the local community
- Launch and oversee new ministries to the community in conjunction with the 2020Vision
- Oversee budgets related to Deacon and Deaconess Committee and Outreach Ministries
- Oversee the Global Reaching Out Team including the Global Reaching Out Conference, Missions Auction, and short-term mission teams
- Provide pastoral care for the CBC supported missionaries
- Give oversight to CBC global reaching out partnerships including HOPE International, Global Disciples, etc.
- Oversee budgets related to global reaching out and the Missions Auction Funds
- Utilize administrative assistant to help with local and global outreach
- Give oversight to the ministries reaching out to the staff, children, and families of Luthercare for Kids, Marietta
- Participate in collaborative community partnerships

Participation as Pastor and Elder

- Serve on Elder Team
- Serve on Ministering Staff Team
- Preach as directed by the Senior Pastor
- Officiate weddings and funerals as requested
- Other pastoral duties as assigned by the Senior Pastor

QUALIFICATIONS

- Demonstrated ability to work well with a committed elder team
- Must be a mature, growing disciple of Jesus Christ who demonstrates His character in his relationships with people and whose life and behavior gives evidence of the fruit of the Spirit as outlined in Gal. 5:22-26
- Must have experience in teaching, training and equipping leadership
- Should have the ability to teach and communicate clearly to groups
- Must be in full agreement with CBC's doctrinal & constitutional statements, work in cooperation with CBC's present philosophy of ministry, and be committed to CBC's core values of loving God, loving others, and reaching out
- Should be able to fulfill and satisfy any additional requirements as referenced in the CBC Employee Handbook

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- Regularly required to remain seated in a normal position for long periods of time
- Occasionally required to stand for long periods of time
- Regularly required to move about
- Regularly required to climb stairs and/or ladders
- Regularly required to maintain balance while walking, standing, crouching, or running
- Occasionally required to stoop, kneel, crouch, and/or crawl
