

Holy Feast Days – 2023



*And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
"Speak to the children of Israel,
and say to them: 'The feasts of the LORD,
which you shall proclaim to be holy
convocations, these are My feasts.'"*

Leviticus 23:1-2

The feasts begin at sunset the night before the date shown.

- Purim: Tuesday, March 7
- Pesach/Passover: Wednesday, April 5 at twilight
- **Feast of Unleavened Bread (Day 1):** Thursday, April 6
- First Fruits: Sunday, April 9
- Counting of the Omer: Sunday, April 9 - Sunday, May 28
- **Feast of Unleavened Bread (Day 7):** Wednesday, April 12
- **Shavuot/Pentecost/Feast of Weeks:** Sunday, May 28
- **Yom Teruah/Feast of Trumpets:** Saturday, September 16
- **Yom Kippur/Day of Atonement:** Monday, September 25
- **Sukkot/Feast of Tabernacles (Day 1):** Saturday, September 30
- **Sukkot/Feast of Tabernacles (Day 8):** Saturday, October 7
- Hanukkah: Thursday, December 7 – Friday, December 15
