

Holy Feast Days - 2023



And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

and say to them: 'The feasts of the LORD,

convocations, these are My feasts.'"

The feasts begin at sunset the night before the date shown.

- Purim: Tuesday, March 7
- Pesach/Passover: Wednesday, April 5 at twilight
- Feast of Unleavened Bread (Day 1): Thursday, April 6
- First Fruits: Sunday, April 9
- Counting of the Omer: Sunday, April 9 Sunday, May 28
- Feast of Unleavened Bread (Day 7): Wednesday, April 12
- Shavuot/Pentecost/Feast of Weeks: Sunday, May 28
- Yom Teruah/Feast of Trumpets: Saturday, September 16
- Yom Kippur/Day of Atonement: Monday, September 25
- Sukkot/Feast of Tabernacles (Day 1): Saturday, September 30
- Sukkot/Feast of Tabernacles (Day 8): Saturday, October 7
- Hanukkah: Thursday, December 7 Friday, December 15
