25 Day Church Challenge Going into the World

Day 1

We know the purpose of the Church is to make disciples.

Matthew 28:18-19 - Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore **ao** and make **disciples**..."

Over the last six weeks, we have looked at the characteristics of a disciple. A disciple is **connecting** with God and other believers, **growing** spiritually in their head, heart and hands, **serving** in the body of Christ, **giving** generously, and **going** into the world.

For a disciple not to have the five characteristics in their life would mean that they are out of balance in their spiritual life.

Day 2
