1 John 2:1-2 - My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense — Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. ² He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.
Romans 8:35-39 - Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall <u>trouble</u> or <u>hardship</u> or <u>persecution</u> or <u>famine</u> or <u>nakedness</u> or <u>danger</u> or <u>sword</u> ? ³⁶ "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered." ³⁷ <u>No</u> , in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, ³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
