

SOAP Daily Devotion – complements the sermon for 8.9.2020

Monday – Ephesians 1:4-6

Perfect unity comes from being united under a perfect God. What brings division to God's family?

What can you do to help grow unity in your church? With other churches?

Tuesday – Colossians 3:11-17

What hinders unity between God's ethnically, culturally, racially, socio-economically diverse children?

What benefits/difficulties would come from investing more time together with brothers and sisters in Christ who are different from you?

Wednesday – Revelation 5:9-10

This is a vision of heaven. John, the Apostle, and writer use a fourfold description of the people Jesus ransomed for God seven times (5:9; 7:9; 10:11; 11:9; 13:7; 14:6; 17:15)! What point do you think he is making?

How easy is it for you to interact with culturally, linguistically, ethnically, and geographically different people from you?

Thursday – Romans 10:8-15

How does this reflect the saying "the ground at the foot of the cross is level"?

Has God grown your interest in sharing Jesus with others? What could you do to improve your heart for people, especially those who are different from you?

Friday – Ephesians 4:7-13

What does the diversity of gifts and roles tell us about how God's family functions best?

In what ways can you help build up the body of Christ and help mature brothers and sisters in Christ?
