

SOAP Daily Devotion – complements the sermon for 1.3.2021

Monday – Luke 5:1-11

What qualities do you think Jesus saw in Peter that would be good for a follower of Jesus?
Which of these qualities do others see in you?

What were Peter, James, and John leaving behind to follow Jesus? What is the biggest thing you left for Jesus?

Tuesday – Luke 6:12-16

How do you think Jesus' praying all night prepared him for the big decision of who he would designate as apostles? How can you tell when God is leading you to pray in preparation for a big decision?

Do you think Jesus knew which one of them would betray him? If you knew who would hurt you in the future, would you invite them into your life, even if God was leading you to do so? Why/why not?

Wednesday – Luke 6:1-9

What do you think was the purpose of Jesus giving the Twelve power and authority to do supernatural things? If Jesus gave you that kind of power, what would it do to you? What would you do with it?

Why do you think Jesus gave them these instructions? What would the disciples learn from this experience? How would you feel about Jesus, demons, and diseases if you were one of the Twelve?

Thursday – Luke 10:1-23

Why do you think Jesus didn't limit his sending to just the 12? Why do you think Jesus sent them out as pairs? What does that mean for you today?

Jesus instructed them to pray for workers and then sent them to be workers. What connection do you find between what you pray and what you feel God leading you to do?

What about Jesus' instructions do you find troubling? Intriguing? Encouraging? What parts, if any, of these instructions to the 72 can we apply to our lives today?

Friday – Luke 11:1-13, Matthew 6:5-15

If you could ask Jesus to teach you one thing, what would it be?

How would you describe the parts or sections of the prayer? Which of these parts of prayer do you find yourself most frequently praying? Why do you think that is?

What do the descriptions around the prayers tell us about the character of God? What would your prayers be like if you saw God in this way?
