

SOAP Daily Devotion – complements the sermon for 11.1.2020

Monday – Ephesians 6:19-24

How would you approach sharing Jesus with others differently if you believe God was giving you the words?

Who is your partner in sharing the good news with others?

Tuesday – Matthew 28:16-20

Is the command “go and make disciples of all nations” just for Jesus, some of us, or all of us? How have you joined in on the mission to “lead people to follow Jesus”?

How does Jesus’ promise to be with you influence your confidence to share the good news of Jesus with others? How can you remind yourself that Jesus is with you and helping you?

Wednesday – Romans 10:9-15

What can you do to help others confess Jesus is Lord, believe God raised him from the dead, and “call on the name of the Lord”?

Why do you think God uses people like you to tell others about Jesus instead of just zapping people with faith?

Thursday – John 3:16-18

Do you believe in Jesus? If someone were to ask you what that means and why you do/don’t believe, how would you explain it to them?

Do you feel that God treats you and others fairly, according to these verses? Do you think this addresses those who have never heard of Jesus? Explain.

Friday – 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

These will be the message texts for the next three weeks. Invest the time to read through these verses five times at different paces. After reading through it five times, try to repeat it to yourself without looking.

With which of the three encouragements do you have trouble? Which comes most naturally?
