Elementary Projects: Kindergarten Reading Skills

--Grade K

Our Kindergarten students will love learning and growing through a multidisciplinary approach to literature, technology and art exploration. As we study books we will integrate other subject areas so that students can make connections through their studies. Students will enjoy many hands on projects to support what they are learning. Included: Alphabet review games, animal rhyme riddles, beginning letter sounds, vowel sounds and blends, word family ladders, phonics, sight words, and much more!

Critical Thinking & Logic: Kindergarten Math Skills

--Grade K

In this multidisciplinary class, students will explore activities to reason, think logically and explore the concept of reasoning, deduction, and numbers. Through games and other fun activities, students will collaborate to solve problems. Among other things, we will play a variety of math games, review colors and shapes, search for missing numbers, and play with pattern block cards. After two semesters, students will have a basic understanding of simple addition, subtraction, place value, and logical thinking skills.

Literature Projects: Kindergarten Imagination Station

--Grade K

Recently incorporated into our Kindergarten program, this multidisciplinary class aims to introduce students to the art of literature while being read a variety of classic and award-winning books. Students will participate in discussions related to our reading and will use manipulatives and other imagination-based products to explore, create and wonder. This sweet class for our youngest will also include hands-on crafts, games or activities related to the literature to further encourage the imagination.

Spanish Culture: Kindergarten Spanish

--Grade K

This is a beginning Spanish multidisciplinary project based course, which emphasizes oral communication in a variety of topics at a basic level. Students will learn basic grammar in an oral/aural context in each class. Students will develop in the four language skills of speaking, listening, very basic reading and writing as well as an appreciation of Spanish culture.

ASL: Kindergarten Sign Language

--Grade K

Through a multidisciplinary approach, students will learn how they can communicate with a Deaf friend, coworker, relative, or other signers. The online class may explore the lives of famous deaf citizens and deaf culture. The hands on project will consist of learning key vocabulary as well as facial expression,

some finger spelling, sentences, and even a song! The goal for this course is conversational skill, through the use of demonstration, constructive feedback on proper hand shapes and motions, classroom practice and confidence-building.
