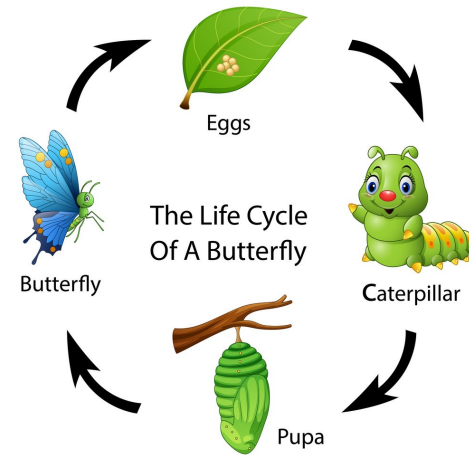


Key Facts
