Critical Final Plays

When a team is the underdog in a high stakes game, it gives them a little more enthusiasm and energy to play with. The score is back-and-forth and the crowd goes wild with every score! It all comes down to the final, critical minutes as to how this one goes down in the history books.

At Ministries of Jesus, we felt like an underdog going into a campaign at the start of a pandemic last year. We weren't sure what plays the opposition would call next, but we were certain God had called us to get in the game. Our eyes were on Him, and He has walked us through with great wisdom. **We are now in the critical final plays and we need your help to finish strong.**

Amazingly, out of a \$3.5 million goal, we are down to the last 12%, or \$410,000 to raise. **What difference will this make? Every last dollar is critical to helping friends in our community find healing:**

Marilyn* came in for charitable dental work but in talking with the Dental Assistant it was obvious she needed to see a counselor. She expressed a clear lack of trust in everyone and high anxiety over many issues. **She agreed Christian counseling would help, but she can't afford it.**

Catherine* has received extensive dental work from MOJ, but she's also been the recipient of medical (ie., routine well woman checks) and counseling services. **She admits she would do without these due to her finances if she had to, but knows her emotional and physical health would suffer.**

Asa Nearly Died From Being Broke

Asa (pictured below) is a gentle, kind-hearted soul. You can see his smile, even hidden behind his mask. He makes a living as a musician and artist. As such, he never really has extra money - especially for medical needs. In 2011, **Asa knew something was wrong.** He lost forty pounds, his eyes started bulging, and he was beginning to shake and tremble, more so all the time. He actually met someone with the same issues. He started asking her questions about the symptoms and she told him it was hyperthyroidism. He asked about treatment and she started talking about radiation, among other overwhelming things. The first thought to cross his mind was, "it sounded expensive." Like most people do, he googled it. After doing a little research he was convinced this disease is what he had. **Asa said, "I wasn't afraid of being sick. I was afraid of dying from being broke because I couldn't afford to go to a doctor and get treatment."**



Not knowing what to do, Asa talked to his mom and sister. His sister had been to Ministries of Jesus and she recommended he call for an appointment. He did, and he got in. That was ten years ago. Turned out, hyperthyroidism was the correct diagnosis. He was able to manage it and get it under control with free medications. Every three months, Asa comes in for a check-up to make sure everything is staying in check. He proudly says, **"I'm an MOJ success story! This place is a huge credit to the community and the people they help."** Years later, Asa's gratitude still overflows. He walked into his appointment recently and told the nurse, **"MOJ saved my life!"**

Asa acknowledges Divine intervention to put the pieces together to get him to MOJ. He really enjoys coming here and shares how he has gotten closer to God in the process. "I thank God this place is here. I could have died from something preventable, just because I couldn't afford to get medical help. I even get dental help here, and I had some major issues with my teeth." He jokingly says on his way out, "I could be a mascot for this place!"

Thankfully, Asa lives a normal life and is back to playing music, joy overflowing; he is truly living life to the full! **There are so many more like Asa that need help. Will you be their difference maker?**



Twenty years has come quickly for Ministries of Jesus. **There hasn't been a day since the doors opened that God hasn't touched a life, provided for a family, brought healing to a hurting soul, or just showed up in ways only He can.**

Much has changed over the years including the location (what better start for what would become a thriving ministry than a small massage parlor?), the leaders, and the services offered. **One thing hasn't changed, and that is keeping the gospel at the center of everything. With such focus on HIS story, many lives have been changed.** Throughout the year, we will be sharing some of those stories with you to celebrate the past two decades and all God has done!

But first, a glance at **how it all began**...As the Spirit led and the pastor preached on what would become a lengthy sermon series focusing on Luke 4:18-19, God began to stir the hearts of His people at Henderson Hills Baptist Church. The question in response was, "If Jesus ministered to spirit, soul, and body, what is He calling us to do?"

A team of church members began seeking, praying, and planning. After 10 months, it was time for ministry to begin. **A lease was signed in November for \$110,000 which the group did not have. They continued praying and miraculously, the total for year end giving, from people they didn't even know, totaled the exact amount needed!**

The **MOJ charitable medical clinic opened in 2001. In 2005, the counseling component was added**, providing services for a need much greater than anticipated. Already growing, a family provided a \$1 million gift to build a place for MOJ on the HHBC campus, which opened in 2007.

In 2009, the dental clinic opened, addressing the connection between good oral health and good physical health. Although these ministries were bearing fruit, it seemed something was missing. At an evening service a young man wandered in off the street looking for a place of comfort and stumbled in to a testimony night about addiction. Afterward, the man handed a pastor his needle and shared about his addiction and need for help. With that, God made it clear this was the missing piece at MOJ and **in 2009, the recovery ministry began.**

Today, MOJ is in a campaign for Restoring Hope for the uninsured, underserved, and broken people in our community. Will you join in and be part of the incredible story God continues to write at MOJ?
