

The Psalms of Grace

Introduction

The Psalms have been an inspiration to many throughout the ages. Many have worshiped God with them and cried tears through them. However, many have been confused and even have had their faith challenged with various passages of the Psalms when in similar troubling situations as the writer; and instead of their faith being built up, they give their minds over to a lie, feeling separation from God, when the truth is that He has never left them. Beyond even this, many have built huge shaky theological structures on the words of the Psalms, trying to relate to them without a foundation of who they are in Jesus Christ and without making a distinction between themselves and the Old Covenant writers, as if the Death and Resurrection of Jesus made no difference at all.

The Grace of God and the New Creation realities that we all have in Jesus Christ are absolutely life changing to say the least and we must make a distinction between the writers of that age, who were waiting to receive the promises of God, and ourselves who have received all blessings in Jesus Christ, the Promise of God. They longed, hungered, and thirsted for the promises of God and rightfully so, because the Promise was yet to come. But we are to be completely satisfied and satiated in our Lord Jesus Christ, because He is the “Yes and Amen” and the fulfillment of every last promise of God to us, and we are partakers of those promises.

Also, the writers of the Psalms lived under the Covenant of Sinai and had a Law/Performance-based mindset, instead of the “freely justified and made perfect by the finished work of Christ” mindset. All of this is important because the writing in the Psalm naturally reflects the state of the writers and we have been brought through Jesus Christ into a completely different state of existence from that which they lived in. They often looked to their own performance and declared their sinfulness; we are to look at the performance of Jesus Christ and see how righteous we are in Him! We shouldn't try to relate ourselves to them, they wrote from a state of fallenness and we are in a state of being perfectly redeemed!

Another major point is they wrote about a world in which they saw as not reconciled, but now at the revelation of the Sacrificed Lamb of God, we should see the world as reconciled to God. The world today is only alienated from God in their own mind, God has already made peace with the world through Jesus Christ. The very ministry that we have been given is to

announce the reconciliation of the whole world to Himself that He has brought through His Son. He has perfect love for every soul, and He loves us freely because He has obliterated every sin and obstacle, having already fully purged every soul from sin by the sufficiency of His finished work of redemption. He is not angry with the world, He loves the world freely and unconditionally, for He IS Love. He has opened up access to the Most Holy Place by His Holy Spirit to all through the torn flesh of Jesus Christ. He wants all to come into the knowledge of the Truth of the Gospel, so that all would interact back with Him on a personal level, as a Father to a beloved child.

I am not trying to give another version, translation, or paraphrase of the book of Psalms. It is a resounding of the Psalms to reflect the New Creation Realities that we now live in. I did not try to stick to the words which are in the original language, this volume is something completely new and only keeps a core resonance of the Psalms of the Bible. I do believe this work will be very edifying to the faith of many. In this book, while being inspired by the Psalms, it is very different in that I take the liberty to completely rewrite the Psalms with a New Covenant perspective, filled with Grace which shifts its focus from wickedness, unto the triumph of righteousness; A perspective that effortlessly enlivens the faith of the children of God in their new identity of Jesus Christ, and encourages them worshipfully enjoy the intoxicating bliss of the God who has made His Home and Temple inside of us. And most importantly to reveal the very Person of Yehovah God, who has completely revealed Himself and so clearly seen in the God-Man Jesus Christ; A God Who is full of Love, Peace, Joy, Patience, Holiness, Forgiveness, Grace, Mercy, and every good thing. A Beautiful God Who is absolutely full of Wonder and Glory, and infinitely incomparable in every way!

In many translations the Name of God is censored as LORD (in all capitals) which in the original Hebrew Text is actually Yehovah. It is used almost 7,000 times in the whole of the Bible, which nearly 750 times of those are in the book of Psalms alone, yet most Christians have no idea what His Name is. In this book, I do use the Name of Yehovah because I would like to see a realization of His Name in the Body of Christ.

I feel that now is similar to the time of the Exodus in this aspect “I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob as God Almighty, but by My Name Yehovah I have not been known to them” (Exodus 6:3). Many of our Church fathers knew Him as God Almighty, but they didn’t know Him by His personal and intimate Name. I do believe that Papa Yehovah wants us

to know that He is not just a Nameless God that goes by the title of “Lord” and that He wants to revive the use of His Name in our day. I know in my own walk with Him, His Name has been something very special to me.

I do want to also state that I do believe in the Trinity, One God manifested as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, whose Name is Yehovah. Before Jesus Christ was incarnated there are many prophecies specifically about Him and He is addressed by the Name of the One True God, Yehovah. I truly believe it brings a lot of glory and revelation of the Deity of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I would also like to suggest that as you read this volume, that you would allow it to be more than just poetical words about God. Rather than just reading about God, become aware of the experiential reality of the truths that these Psalms of Grace testify of. For example, if there is a verse that speaks of the pleasure of God that He has placed in your heart, allow yourself to feel and enjoy the reality of His delightful pleasure that is within you already in this very moment. If it speaks of the boundless love of God burning within and around you, realize that is true for you now and feel His love just enwrapping you. If it speaks of making an ecstatic shout of praise to the Lord, let it inspire you to vocalize a joyful noise really unto Him, whatever that may sound like.

Also, the Presence of God is not a strange and far away vaporous thing that comes and goes, but His Presence is Himself; He is a living Person that has sworn to never leave you. Even in this very moment as you read this, He is with you and you can sense His Presence if you just allow yourself to become aware that He is with you. He is a Living Spirit, alive in this very moment, and when you begin to feel Him, it's not that He is “showing up” or coming to you at that moment, rather He was there all along and you are beginning to feel Him just because you have opened yourself to the reality that He is truly with you always. God is perfectly practicing your presence all the time, as the classic Psalm 139 gives witness to, that in His love He is always watching over you, knows all your words, actions, thoughts, and it is impossible to find a place where His Presence isn't there. Just allow yourself at this very moment to become aware of His Presence that is with you.

God is our Father and He never meant us to confine knowing Him to just knowledge about Himself or that our communication with Him be limited to reading a book that talks about Him; He has always wanted us to know Him directly and experientially. This was the very purpose of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, that we have now been

permanently brought into the Most Holy Place, where we can know God personally and experientially; This truth is not meant to just be part of our theologies and belief systems, but to be experienced in our daily lives amongst the work, school, family, hobbies, or whatever it is you do throughout your day. But even this is not something you have to try to experience, the truth is you have been there all along, whether you have realized it or not.

I encourage you to realize that He is alive, a Living Spirit, that He is very real in the realm that you live in. Allow yourself to have a direct interaction with the Person of God. You can use the eyes of faith to see Him. Many people believe that they cannot see God, but ironically the only person who wrote that, the Apostle John, writes a very detailed record himself seeing God, as seen in all throughout the book of Revelation. Also, there are many people throughout the whole of the Bible who are recorded as seeing God. Jesus said that the pure in heart would see God, and you have been given a pure heart as a New Creation in Christ. So clearly the interpretation of not being able to see God is something very different than what many people have thought it to mean. So come boldly before His Throne of Grace, Jesus Christ is the new and living way! With the eyes of your heart, just see Him with the various pictures He has painted in the scriptures. One would be from Revelation 1: "I saw One who looked like the Son of Man. He was dressed in a long robe with a golden sash around His chest. The hairs of His head were white, like white wool, like snow. His eyes were like flames of fire. His feet were glowing like bronze being heated in a furnace, and his voice sounded like a roaring waterfall...His Face was like the sun when it shines in all its brightness". His perfect peace is realized in the one whose imagination is fixed on Him, because in Him we all have found our rest.

There is not a single blessing or good thing that is written of in this volume that you do not already have. Papa Yehovah in His exceedingly abundant Grace has given all of it freely to us in His Son, Jesus Christ, and you are a New Creation in Him. So as you read these Psalms, allow yourself to become aware of the reality of all the blessings that He has already permanently placed in your life.

Saturated in the bliss and enjoyment of my God at all times, with infinite unending love for you all,

Psalms of Grace 1

(1) Happy is the New Man in Jesus Christ! He has been brought into the counsel of God, he walks on the path of the blameless, and he does not accept the words of those who scoff in unbelief about the Gospel.

(2) All His bliss is in the Spirit of Yehovah, and he is continuously aware of His Presence day and night.

(3) His rest is in the vine of Christ, and he is full of the intoxication of the River of Life. Each fruit will come forth in its due season, and his life shall be everlasting. All which he does prospers.

(4) Wickedness has completely passed away from him; it is as chaff which the Holy Spirit has blown away. He has been created anew with the very nature of the Father; he embodies the infinite Love of God.

(5) By the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, all wickedness has fallen to the King's judgment. Now there is a glorious congregation of His righteous children which stand before Him.

(6) The way of wickedness has been destroyed, and Papa Yehovah has freely gifted us with the way of His righteousness in His Son Jesus Christ!

Psalms of Grace 2

(1) The nations rave and the peoples rejoice in the Salvation of God!

(2) The kings of the earth have bowed themselves. Yea, the rulers plan together with Yehovah and His Messiah, saying,

(3) "We will enjoy our Union with Him, and glory in our Bond with Him".

(4) The Lord sits on His Throne in the Heavens and laughs. The Lord sings songs of love over them.

(5) Then He will speak to them in His Bliss, and He will affirm them in His passion,

(6) "Yea, I have appointed the King of Kings, Jesus Christ, on My holy mount in Zion".

(7) I will declare concerning the decree of Yehovah: He said to Me, "You are My Beloved Son. I am Your God and Father, know always that it is I who has begotten You.

(8) You asked of Me, and I have given the nations as Your inheritance and the uttermost parts of the earth as Your possession.

(9) You have broken the wicked powers with a rod of iron, You have dashed them in pieces like a potter's vessel".

(10) Now then, be wise O kings. Be taught, O judges of the earth.

(11) Serve Yehovah with awe; yea, rejoice with shaking.

(12) Kiss the Son, for He is worthy! You will never perish from the Way, for His passion is kindled forever! Oh the blessings of all those who have found safety in His embrace!

Psalms of Grace 3

(1) O Yehovah, You are victorious over all the adversaries! Many fallen are the evil ones who rose against us.

(2) Many were the ones who said of my soul, "There is no deliverance for him in God". Selah.

(3) But You, O Yehovah, are a shield around me, my Glory, and He who lifts up my head. You have clearly revealed that You are for me.

(4) I prayed to Yehovah with my voice, and He heard me out of His holy mountain. Selah.

(5) I laid down, and slept; I awoke, for Yehovah protected me from the all evil that may lurk in the night.

(6) I was not afraid of the many that once had been set against me all around.

(7) For You, O Yehovah, have arisen! My God, you have saved me! You have struck all evil powers on the cheekbone. You have broken the power of wickedness.

(8) Salvation has been brought to us by Yehovah God in Jesus Christ. All of Your blessings are on Your people. Selah.

Psalms of Grace 4

(1) You answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness. You are always there for me in times of distress. You are gracious to me and You hear my prayer.

(2) "O sons of men, now is the time to realize My Glory! I have filled you with my infinite love and grand purposes! Will you come with Me and hear the Truth?" Selah.

(3) Know that Yehovah has sanctified Man as godly for Himself. Yehovah hears when you call to Him.

(4) You do not sin because your trust is in Him. Listen to Him within your own heart on your bed in the place of silence and stillness. Selah.

(5) Be confident in Yehovah, for the Sacrifice of righteousness has been made in Jesus Christ.

(6) Many have said, "Who will make us see any good?" But You, O Yehovah, radiate the light of Your Face on us in great favor.

(7) You have put exceedingly great gladness in my heart, more than in the time of their grain and their wine grew, more than the time of the rich in their success.

(8) I will both lie down in peace and sleep, for You alone, O Yehovah, have made me to dwell in safety.

Psalms of Grace 5

(1) You listen to my words, O Yehovah and are mindful of my meditation.

(2) My King and my God, You attend to the voice of my heart, for I pray to You.

(3) I make my voice to be heard by You in the morning, O Yehovah, I am mindful of Your Presence even in the dawning of the day. I continuously gaze upon Your Face in the Heavens.

(4) You are a God enjoying righteousness. Because You have made me holy, You now live with me.

(5) We are boasters in what Christ has done, for He has set us before Your eyes. You are pleased with us in Your Son Jesus, the Worker of Righteousness.

(6) You have established us in the spoken Truth of Your Gospel. Papa Yehovah rejoices because of the Man who shed His blood with purity.

(7) I, in the abundance of Your Grace, have come into Your house. I will worship You always, basking in Your overwhelming love in Your holy temple, O Yehovah.

(8) You lead me in Your righteousness; You have made straight Your Way of Love before me.

(9) There is only faithfulness in Your mouth. Our inward being is now in everlasting holiness, our throats are filled with Your sweet words like honey. Indeed we are flattered by Your words.

(10) O God, you hold us guiltless and we have been exalted in Your counsel for redemption. You have driven away the multitude of our transgressions, even though we once rebelled against You.

(11) All who put their trust in You rejoice. They shout in ecstatic joy forever, because You have purified them of all their sins. All those who love Your Name are blissful in You.

(12) For You, O Yehovah, have blessed us in Jesus Christ, the Righteous One and You surround us with favor as with a shield.

Psalms of Grace 6

- (1) O Yehovah, You are relentless for me in Your passion and You have made me new in your burning heart of bliss.
- (2) You had mercy on me, O Yehovah, for I was weak. You healed me, O Papa Yehovah, for my bones were troubled, and you have restored me to complete wholeness.
- (3) My soul also has been greatly relieved in You, O Yehovah my God.
- (4) O Papa Yehovah, Your Presence is ever with me and You have glorified my soul. You saved me, for Your love is unshakeable.
- (5) You have granted me eternal life, and in this immortality I shall give thanks to You forever.
- (6) I am refreshed in Your Presence, so I will make known my worship to You. Because of Your goodness My bed swim in tears of joy all the night, I sit on my couch and melt in your fiery love.
- (7) My eyes are bright because of Your Light, they are restored because of the unveiling of your Holy Son.
- (8) Let us assemble, all the children of God, for Papa Yehovah has heard the voice of our laughter.
- (9) Yehovah has heard my heart; the Lord Yehovah receives my prayer.
- (10) All evil is ashamed and greatly troubled; it has turned back, ashamed in a moment, for Jesus Christ is victorious!

Psalms of Grace 7

- (1) O Yehovah my God, I have found refuge in You. You have saved me from all who once pursued me, and You were my deliverance.
- (2) They desired like a lion to tear my soul apart and to rend it to pieces, but You alone were there with me, completely faithful to deliver me.
- (3) O Yehovah my God, I am found in Your Son Jesus Christ, so there is no more iniquity on my hands.
- (4) By Your power I am found doing good even to my enemies, I have given even to the one oppressing me without cause.
- (5) Your faithfulness has pursued and overtaken my soul. Yea, You raised up my life from the Earth, and given me exalted honor in the Heavens. Selah.
- (6) You have arisen, O Yehovah, in Your Passion. You were lifted up on the Cross in Christ at the rage of those who were in ignorance, and You have Resurrected for me! You have fulfilled all judgment.
- (7) The assembly of the nations has surrounded You, and over it You have ascended, now reigning from Heaven.

(8) Yehovah has judged the people righteous. O Papa Yehovah, You have judged me according to the righteousness of Jesus Christ, according to the perfection of Your Holy Son.

(9) The power of evil in the wicked has come to an end and You have established the just in Christ. For the righteous God has purified our hearts and minds.

(10) God is my shield, He is the Savior, the very righteousness of my heart.

(11) God is a righteous judge, He is pleased with His Beloved Son every day, and we are found in Him.

(12) At the goodness of God a man repents. When he has a revelation of the Lamb of God who was slain, his heart and mind is changed. God has bent and readied His bow;

(13) He has showered down His fiery arrows on every heart across the world, making the fire of the Gospel to burn within all men.

(14) Behold, righteousness is within every man and all are pregnant with destiny and are called to give birth to greatness and truth.

(15) All have died and were in the grave with Jesus Christ,

(16) and all have raised to life in Him. The crown of life has come down as a gift to all.

(17) I will thank Yehovah always for the gift of His righteousness, and will praise the Name of Yehovah Most High forever!

Psalms of Grace 8

(1) O Yehovah our Lord, how majestic is Your Name in all the earth. You have set Your Glory above the Heavens!

(2) From the mouths of children and infants come songs of praise to You. They sing of Your power and silence the wise of the world with the wisdom of Christ.

(3) When I consider as I look upon the vastness and splendor of Your Heavens, the work of Your fingers: the sun, the moon, the stars, and all of the celestial hosts of the Universe, which You have created and set in its place;

(4) What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man, that You have made Your eternal dwelling place within him?

(5) For You once made me a little lower than the angels, but now have crowned me with glory and honor.

(6) You have set me to rule over all the creation of Your hands. You have put all under My feet:

(7) all flocks and oxen, and also the animals of the field,

(8) the birds of the heavens, and the fish of the sea, even all that pass through the sea.

(9) O Yehovah our Lord, how majestic is Your Name in all the earth!

Psalms of Grace 9

(1) I will give thanks to You, O Yehovah, with all my heart. I will tell of all Your wonderful acts.

(2) I will be exceedingly glad and rejoice in the pleasures of Your infinitely ravishing Nature. I will praise Your Name, O Most High.

(3) All wickedness has turned back, it has fallen and perished before You.

(4) For You have established my righteousness and my destiny. You sat on the throne judging rightly.

(5) You have redeemed the nations and You have raised Your Kingdom. You have established Your dominion forever and ever.

(6) The desolations of the enemy are ended forever and their memory has perished with them. You have established the cities of Your Kingdom.

(7) Papa Yehovah is seated forever. He has established His White Throne of Judgment to make manifest Grace.

(8) For He has judged the world as righteous, He shall judge the peoples in the blamelessness of His Son Jesus Christ.

(9) Yehovah has become a refuge for the oppressed, a house of safety in times of distress.

(10) And those who know Your Name will put their trust in You. For You, Papa Yehovah, will never forsake those who are found in Christ.

(11) Sing praises to Yehovah who dwells in the New Jerusalem above. Declare His Gospel among the nations.

(12) For He remembers them, He does not forget the cry of the afflicted.

(13) You are gracious to me, O Yehovah. You saw my affliction from the evil ones hating me, and you raised me up from the gates of death.

(14) Now I declare all Your praises in the gates of Jerusalem above. I am exhilarated with the lively and pleasurable sensations in Your salvation.

(15) The nations have also been raised from the grave; their feet have been established on the Way of righteousness.

(16) Yehovah has made Himself known through Jesus Christ. He has executed judgment; wickedness has been destroyed by the piercings of His hands. Selah.

(17) The Kingdom of Heaven shall be seen on Earth. All the nations shall perpetually give praise to our God.

(18) The needy have been remembered, the Hope of the poor has come to us forever.

(19) You have arisen, O Yehovah! All men will find their strength in Christ Jesus. For the nations are renewed in Your Presence.

(20) O Papa Yehovah, give revelation and knowledge of the Gospel to them, let the nations know they are Your glorious children. Selah.

Psalms of Grace 10

(1) You are never far away, O Holy Spirit of Yehovah. You show Yourself faithful and strong in times of distress.

(2) The righteous in his love will relieve the poor, for they are rewarded and honored for walking according to Your will.

(3) But the righteous boasts in the God of his soul, and he has blessed His Holy Name; he has glorified Yehovah, who is his Father.

(4) In the shining of Christ's Face, he clearly sees the fullness of the Glory of God. All of his thoughts declare, "Truly my God is with me".

(5) His ways are perfect at all times. Your judgments are always within his vision. As for all that may be distressing to him, he has placed it into Your hand.

(6) He has said in his heart, "I shall not be moved! From generation to generation never will I be in evil", for his trust is in the Son of God.

(7) His mouth is full of wisdom, truth, and healing; under his tongue are words of grace, joy, and purpose.

(8) He sits as a light to the villages. In the secret place of His Temple within, he prays to the Holy One. His eyes constantly look into the Face of Glory.

(9) As he enjoys the Presence of the Living God in the secret place of Christ he is moved in great compassion for the poor; he lifts up the poor, drawing him into the Person of refuge.

(10) And the poor being restored, he bows in worship to God. Yea, the weak have been found in the Strong One and the poor have been made rich in His abundance.

(11) He has said in his heart, "God has remembered. He has revealed His Face and He watches over me forever".

(12) You have arisen, O Yehovah! O God, You have lifted up Your hand, for You have not forgotten the lowly ones.

(13) The redeemed are eternally grateful to God. They say in their heart, "You have forgiven us, O Father, and given us great favor".

(14) You have seen, for You also take note of those in distress and grief, to freely give with Your hand. The poor leaves himself to You. You are the Helper of the orphan.

(15) You have broken the arm of the wicked and evil one and You continually destroyed all wickedness until You found none.

(16) Yehovah is King forever and ever! the nations have been redeemed out of all the earth.

(17) O Papa Yehovah, You have heard the desire of the humble; You have prepared their heart. Your ear will always be opened to hear.

(18) You bring justice to the oppressed and are the Father of the orphan. No more shall the man of the earth continue to terrify. Your Kingdom, O God, has come!

Psalms of Grace 11

(1) I have found refuge in Yehovah; how can you say to my soul, "Flee like a bird to your nest"?

(2) For behold! The wicked bend the bow, they have fitted their arrow to the string to shoot in the dark at the upright in heart.

(3) But the righteous trust in Jesus Christ, a foundation which cannot be destroyed.

(4) Yehovah is in His holy temple, the Lord Yehovah, on His Throne in the Heavens. His eyes see, His seven Spirits watch over the sons of men.

(5) Yehovah has established them in the Righteous One, but He has destroyed wickedness, the powers loving evil.

(6) He has rained all of His blessings on the righteous: fire, bliss, and the refreshing of His Holy Spirit is the portion of their cup.

(7) For Yehovah is righteous, He loves good works, done cheerfully in Love. The blameless in Christ enjoy His Presence and gaze upon His Face of unending Light!

Psalms of Grace 12

(1) You are our help, O Yehovah, for the godly are established forever, and the faithful multiply from among the sons of men.

(2) They speak edification, each man with his neighbor. With truthful lips and a pure heart they speak.

(3) Yehovah has established all with lips that speak of the Truth in the Gospel and the tongue that speaks great things about our God and Father;

(4) Who say, "We shall be strong by the Holy Spirit of His Son! Our lips belong to our God, for we have chosen Him as Lord over us!"

(5) "For the pain of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, I will now rise up" says Yehovah, "I will reveal to him that I am the safety and restoration for which he hops and longs for."

(6) The Words of Yehovah are pure Words. Your Word, Christ Jesus, has purified our hearts like silver refined in a fiery furnace, purified seven times over.

(7) You shall keep watch over Your children, O Papa Yehovah. You shall keep them in incorruptibility in this generation forever.

(8) The righteous walk around on every side in all the face of the earth, and holiness is exalted by the sons of men.

Psalms of Grace 13

(1) You have set me in Your remembrance forever, O Papa Yehovah. You have revealed Your Face to me in Your Son Jesus Christ.

(2) Every day You set Your counsel in my soul, placing cheerfulness in my heart every day! No longer is the enemy lifted up over me.

(3) I am ever grateful to You, for You look over me with a protecting watch and have answered me when I call, O Yehovah my God. You have enlightened my eyes and given me understanding that I shall never taste death.

(4) For death was an enemy, but You have said, "I have overcome death in My Resurrection". Now the powers of darkness tremble when they see the unending Light of Your Holy Spirit radiating through me.

(5) I have trusted in Your abundance of Grace, for my heart is filled with the ecstasy of Your salvation.

(6) I will sing to Yehovah, because He has rewarded me with everlasting life in Christ Jesus.

Psalms of Grace 14

(1) The wise in Christ have said in their heart, "Truly we are in Union with God!" They acted in purity; they are filled with love in deeds. Many are those doing good.

(2) Yehovah looked from Heaven on the sons of mankind, to see if there were any discerning, any aware of the Presence of God.

(3) The peoples are renewed in the knowledge of Christ Jesus, together they have all become pure in Him. There are many doing good, they are living out of the Righteous One!

(4) They feast on the Lamb of God and drink the cup of His Blood. They have ascended into the heavenly realm and stand in awe of the Lord Yehovah.

(5) There they are in great rapture, for the unending bliss of God's Presence is in this righteous generation.

(6) Yehovah has made His counsel toward the afflicted in favor, for He is their refuge.

(7) He is the One who has brought the salvation of Israel out of Zion. Yehovah has brought His people out of the bondage of sin, so they are exhilarated as they rejoice in the enjoyment of His Presence. Indeed, the Israel of God has been made glad!

Psalms of Grace 15

(14) Yea, He sent out His arrows and scattered them; and He shot out lightnings and confounded them.

(16) He sent help from on high and He caught me up. He drew me out of many waters.

- (17) He delivered me from the enemy, and from that which desired to destroy me; for He is stronger than them all.

- (19) He brought me out into the Heavens. He rescued me because He is delighted with me in Christ.

- (7) The voice of Yehovah flashes forth flames of fire.
- (8) The voice of Yehovah whirls the desert sand and because of the voice of Yehovah, the desert near Kadesh shivers and trembles.
- (9) The voice of Yehovah gives life, making the animals give birth in their time, and His voice gives the cycle of seasons. Everyone in His temple shouts forth, "Glory!"
- (10) The Lord Yehovah has dominion over all creation. Yea, Yehovah sits enthroned as King forever.
- (11) The Omnipotent Spirit of Yehovah has spoken forth eternal righteous in Christ Jesus to His people. Yehovah, our Father whose voice is great in power, has spoken forth the announcement of peace to all peoples. Selah.

Psalms of Grace 30

- (1) I exalt You, O Lord Yehovah, for You have glorified me and have made me to rejoice in victory over all enemies.
- (2) O Papa Yehovah, I am found in Your Son Jesus, and in Him You have given divine health to me, even youthfulness to my flesh.

(13) The Lord Yehovah looks from Heaven and He sees all the sons of mankind.

(14) From His dwelling place He looks on all the ones living in the earth.

(22) Your unmerited Grace is upon us, O Yehovah, so we will continuously rest in You.

(20) You have repaid good even to those who hated You. They may speak slanders towards You, but Your unrelenting goodness still follows them.

(21) O Papa Yehovah, I thank You that You have never given up on me! O my God, even in my mistakes, You are never far from me.

(22) In those moments, You make haste to help me. I am eternally grateful to You, O my Lord, my Savior.

Psalms of Grace 39

(1) I will boldly declare the Gospel of Jesus Christ! I am a sinless being because His Blood was sufficient to cleanse me. His righteousness is truly manifested in me, empowered by His Holy Spirit, to keep my ways from ever falling into the path of sinning. He is the power who has perfected my tongue and fills my speech with grace.

- (7) And now what do I await, my Father? My hope is in You!
- (8) You had delivered me from all my transgressions when I was crucified and raised with Christ. You have made me to partake of the most honorable seat of Glory in the Highest Heavens.
- (9) I will not be mute; I will open my mouth, because You have done it!
- (10) Truly You have sworn to never be angry with me forever. I am consumed by the fire of Your Everlasting Love.
- (11) You guide your children with a tender heart and with Your flames of love You melted us with sweet holy desires. Surely every man has a future of grand destiny. Selah.
- (12) You have heard my prayer, O Papa Yehovah, and given ear to my desires. You have brought me into the tears of ecstasy in Your goodness, for I am Your beloved son. I am one who had been away on a long journey, but has now come home into the eternal embrace of You, my God and my loving Father.
- (13) You see me as I am, and You have accepted me and have unconditionally loved me. You have warmed my heart, so I am immensely cheerful to dwell in the bliss of Your house and to be with You forevermore!

Psalms of Grace 40

- (1) All of my hope is in Yehovah my God. He has turned to me and carried my soul.
- (2) He lifted me out of the grave. He lifted me from that lonely and muddy place. He picked me up, setting me on the Solid Rock, who keeps my feet from slipping, for He is my Strength.

(13) You became a disgrace in the sight of the people, a scorn and a mockery to those who saw You in Your weakness.

(14) You were called accursed amongst the nation, a derision among the peoples.

(15) Your humiliation was before them all the day; yea, your Face was shamed, covered in blood and spit,

(16) Because of the accuser's voice and the blasphemer, who held a list of our transgressions before You.

(17) All this had come upon You, and we have not forgotten You nor the price You paid with Your Blood for this New Covenant.

(18) But Your heart was not turned back and your steps did not swerved from the way of Your Passion, for You went through to the end.

(19) You are the Holy One who was Crucified and pierced, taking the place of sinners, in death. But You conquered sin and the grave in Your Resurrection and You are alive forever more!

(20) We will never forget the Name of our God, or ever turn our eyes to another,

(21) For Yehovah God is our great Redeemer who sought out our Salvation. He has made known the mystic secret of His heart, His Holy Son, Jesus Christ.

(22) Yea, He is the Lamb who was slain before the foundations of the world; He is the Lamb who is exulted in Your courts forever!

(23) Be awakened to the Truth of the Gospel! Do not be asleep, awaken! For God has brought us into Union with Himself forever.

(24) You have revealed the Glory of Your Presence to us. You did not leave us in affliction and distress.

(25) Our soul has been enraptured into the Heavens and our feet are forever established on the Earth.

(26) O God, You are the Mighty One who arose for our help. You have made manifest the revelation of our Salvation in Your Grace!

Psalms of Grace 45

(*In this Psalm, the King specifically refers to Jesus Christ while the Eternal Emperor refers to God the Father)

(1) A Mystical Poem of the Lamb's Marriage. A Song of the Beloved.

(10) Hearken, O daughter and bride, consider and incline your ear. Forget your past where your kinsmen desire to bring to remembrance and give account of a shameful history.

(11) The King has searched you out and has found no such thing, He only sees and greatly desires your perfect beauty, that of your appearance and of your heart. He is your Lord and He has fallen completely in love with you. He is truly ravishing, His perfection and radiant Glory make it irresistible to worship Him.

(12) The most honorable of the Lord's angels have come to bring you a marriage gift, and the richest among the nations shower you with their treasures.

(13) The Queen is all glorious. She is the Eternal Emperor's daughter, dwelling in His Celestial Palace. She is a princess magnificently dressed, she is beautiful in her robes which are woven with the purest of gold.

(14) At the Wedding Ceremony, her dress is dazzling in the most glorious Light of Holy Spirit. Her God and Father leads her in to the Bridegroom-King. After her the virgins, her companions, follow in her train and also were introduced to the King.

(15) They are escorted in with great gladness of heart and rejoicing in ecstasy at the consummation of the Union at the Wedding. They also have been brought into the grand delights of the King's Heavenly Palace and take unending pleasure as they dance at the celebration feast.

(16) The Father has revealed His plans to make Your sons to be immortal rulers in Glory over all the earth.

(17) O Yehovah God in Christ Jesus, I will bring remembrance to Your Name in every generation perpetually. On this account, people shall thank You forever and ever!

(8) Come and behold the works of Yehovah. He is the One who brings Heavenly Paradise on the Earth.

- (9) He brings peace, causing wars to cease across all of the Earth. He breaks the bow, cuts apart spears, and He burns the chariots in the fire.
- (10) “Be still and know that I AM God! I AM exalted among the nations, I AM exalted in all the Earth”.
- (11) Yehovah of Hosts is with us always, the God of the Universe is a safe refuge for us. Selah.

Psalms of Grace 47

- (1) All people clap your hands! Shout aloud unto God with loud songs of His joyful triumph!
- (2) For Yehovah Most High is awesome! The Great King over all the Heavens and the Earth.

- (10) Your Name is great, O Yehovah God! Your fame and Glory extends to the ends of the earth. Your right hand is full of righteousness.
- (11) We have come to Mount Zion and are exceedingly glad. The Lion of the Tribe of Judah has roared in His great joy because He has triumphed in manifesting Your Grace.
- (12) People of God, walk around the New Jerusalem and count the towers,
- (13) Behold the glorious citadels and see the marvelous palaces that you may tell the next generation about them.
- (14) For this Heaven of our God is in the Person of our God forever and ever. And He shall be our Heaven and the fullness of our bliss even unto eternity! HalleluYah!

Psalms of Grace 49

- (1) Hear this, all peoples. Give ear, all those living in the world,
- (2) Both low and high, rich and poor alike.
- (3) My mouth shall speak wisdom, and the thoughts of my heart shall be of understanding.
- (4) I have in mind a mystery that I will reveal while playing my strings.
- (5) Jesus Christ tasted death so we don't have to, and has abolished the devil, the one who held the power of death. Why then should I ever fear death?
- (6) So trust in the riches and treasures of Life and Glory in Christ Jesus. Make your boast and place your confidence in Him.
- (7) For He being God became a man like us. He has redeemed us and glorified us, making us worthy to be called His brothers. The Father has given Him as a ransom on behalf of us all,
- (8) For the redemption of our souls was precious to Him, and IT IS FINISHED forever!
- (9) In Him we shall yet live forever, and in Him we shall never see corruption.
- (10) For He sees to it that His wise ones will not die, those who trust in the "foolishness" of His Finished Work at the Cross. His favor is upon them to gain riches in the world, but those who refuse to believe in His free gift of immortality will perish and leave their riches to others.

- (16) You are my precious child, I have placed my ways of unfailing love in your mind and in your heart. In My New Covenant with you, I have made you a New Creation in Union with Myself.
- (17) Yea, you have loved my teaching and guiding. The Words of My Spirit are constantly in your ears.

(18) When someone did you wrong, you had forgiven him and loved him. Every good thing that I own is your portion.

(19) Your mouth gives forth Grace, and your tongue announces Truth.

(20) You sit in peace with your brother. Though he may have wrongly offended you, you remain in unity with him and have joy in him.

(21) You have done these things, and I have seen your heart in secret. I have made you all together like Myself. Your true identity is brought back to remembrance as You look at Me in My Holy Son, Christ Jesus. You are My reflection.

(22) Now think of this: I am your God, I am your Father who has given birth to you. You have been generated out of Me and you are created from My essence.

(23) By giving thanks and enjoying Me, you glorify Me. My Presence will always be with you. I am your God, and I have revealed to you, My holy child, the bliss of my salvation. Again, be aware that I am always with you and that I will forever love you”.
