

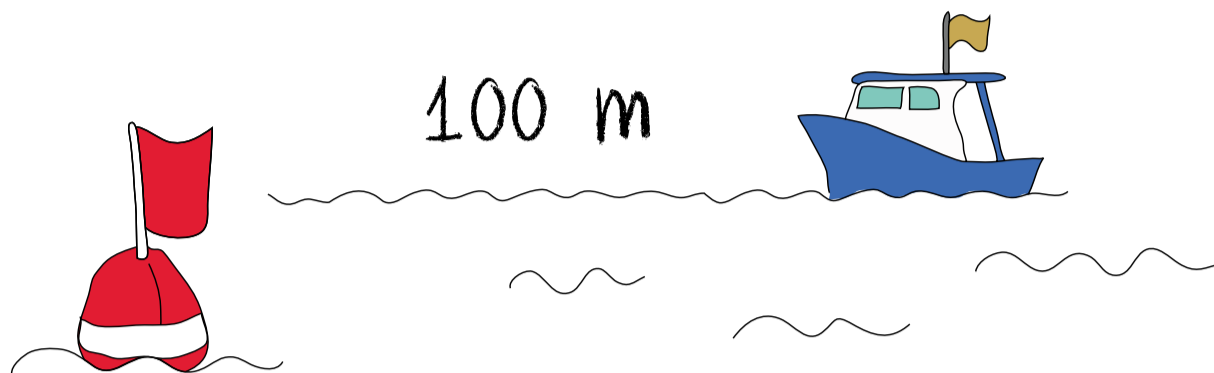

## Prevention on board

### 5 safety rules for boaters



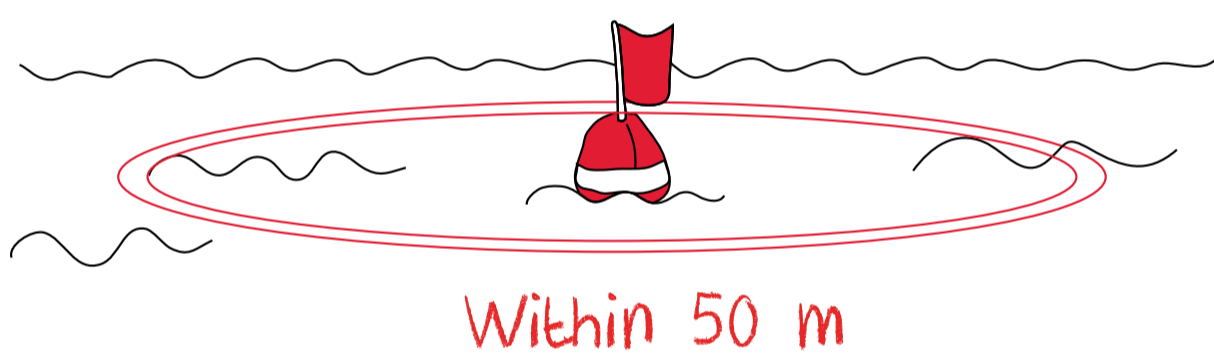
- Stay at least 100 m away from diver-down/alpha flags.
- Do not let anyone onto the swim platform while the engine is in gear.
- Ensure that divers stay away from the propeller which is sharp and dangerous even when immobile.
- Allow easy and safe re-boarding.
- Before starting the engine, make sure no diver is nearby or under the boat.



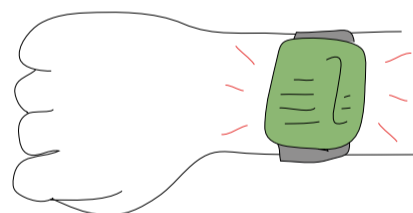
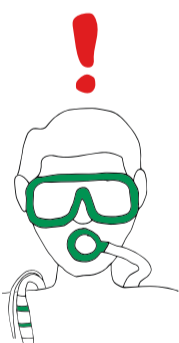
## Prevention while diving

### 5 safety rules for divers

- Always place the diver-down/alpha flag before diving, ensuring it is clearly visible from all directions.




- Always surface within 50 m of your dive flag.
- Use a surface marker buoy if an emergency surfacing far from the diver-down flag is needed.
- Watch your buoyancy and avoid uncontrolled ascents.
- While ascending, look around and pay utmost attention.
