## Our Concert Series

**All concerts begin at 3 p.m. on the second Sunday of the month (October through March). Doors open at 2:30 p.m. To minimize exposure risks, we require proof of full immunization (at least 14 days since the final dose) or a COVID-19 PCR negative test result within 72-hours prior, or a negative COVID-19 antigen test result within 6-hours prior. A valid government issued ID is required for verification of immunization status.**



# Location

Peace Memorial Presbyterian Church (110 S. Fort Harrison Avenue) is located at the NW corner of Fort Harrison Avenue and Pierce Street in downtown Clearwater.

During peak traffic times, you may wish to use Myrtle Avenue and access the church by way of Pierce or Park Streets.



# Parking | Accessibility

Ample free parking is available in four nearby lots:

- Directly across Fort Harrison Avenue in front of the Church (east side) with lot entrances via Pierce and Park Streets;
- Directly behind the Church (west side) entering from Pierce Street is **designated handicap parking** and **ramp access** to the Sanctuary;
- Directly behind the Church (west side) in the old City Hall Building Lot;
- Directly north of the Church in the Pinellas County Utilities Building Lot (14 S. Fort Harrison Avenue).
