Passiontide.....

We will hear the Passion of Our Lord read at Mass today.

Passion means '**suffering**' and we've been working on our devotion to the Lord's Passion during these weeks of Lent.....

We've followed the Lord along the Way of the Cross to Calvary, we've meditated upon the Scriptures and attended formation sessions. We've adored the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. We have worked on our prayer, fasting and almsgiving....

We've denied the self in imitation of Jesus, we've attended Mass at 7:30 in the morning! Now we enter the final days of true devotion.

Today we recall the Lord's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, greeted with shouts of joyful 'hosanna' only for those cries to change to 'crucify Him' by Friday.

In these Days of Passiontide / Holy Week let's make an extra special effort to be with the Lord.



Choir practice:


The Parish Choir meets after Mass every Sunday. They are currently working hard practicing music for Holy Week. If you would like to join the choir, come along!



Passion Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week.....

Next Sunday is Passion Sunday (sometimes referred to as 'Palm Sunday') which begins for us the most important week of the year for every Catholic.


Next Sunday begins Holy Week which includes the Sacred Triduum – Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. **These three days together make one Liturgy.**

It's important that we make every effort to attend these Sacred and most Holy days of our Religion:

DIVINE MERCY

JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU!

Divine Mercy Indulgence: 24th April 2022

We may obtain an Indulgence for any deceased person we choose on the Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday. The Indulgence is applied to the soul of the deceased person at the moment of death.

In order to obtain the Indulgence we must (i) Go to Confession (ii) receive Holy Communion (iii) pray for the Holy Father's intentions (iv) participate in the veneration of the Image of Divine Mercy. We may also wish to keep the Novena (9 days of prayer) beginning on Good Friday. Here are the intentions for the Novena:

- DAY ONE "Today bring to Me ALL MANKIND, ESPECIALLY ALL SINNERS, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. In this way you will console Me in the bitter grief into which the loss of souls plunges Me."
- DAY TWO "Today bring to Me THE SOULS OF PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS, and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy. It was they who gave Me strength to endure My bitter Passion. Through them as through channels My mercy flows out upon mankind."
- DAY THREE: "Today bring to Me ALL DEVOUT AND FAITHFUL SOULS, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. The souls brought Me consolation on the Way of the Cross. They were that drop of consolation in the midst of an ocean of bitterness."
- DAY FOUR "Today bring to Me THOSE WHO DO NOT BELIEVE IN GOD AND THOSE WHO DO NOT YET KNOW ME. I was thinking also of them during My bitter Passion, and their future zeal comforted My Heart. Immerse them in the ocean of My mercy."
- DAY FIVE "Today bring to Me THE SOULS OF THOSE WHO HAVE SEPARATED THEMSELVES FROM MY CHURCH, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. During My bitter Passion they tore at My Body and Heart, that is, My Church. As they return to unity with the Church, My wounds heal and in this way they alleviate My Passion."

- DAY SIX** "Today bring to Me THE MEEK AND HUMBLE SOULS AND THE SOULS OF LITTLE CHILDREN, and immerse them in My mercy. These souls most closely resemble My Heart. They strengthened Me during My bitter agony. I saw them as earthly Angels, who will keep vigil at My altars. I pour out upon them whole torrents of grace. Only the humble soul is capable of receiving My grace. I favour humble souls with My confidence."
- DAY SEVEN** "Today bring to Me THE SOULS WHO ESPECIALLY VENERATE AND GLORIFY MY MERCY, and immerse them in My mercy. These souls sorrowed most over my Passion and entered most deeply into My spirit. They are living images of My Compassionate Heart. These souls will shine with a special brightness in the next life. Not one of them will go into the fire of hell. I shall particularly defend each one of them at the hour of death."
- DAY EIGHT** "Today bring to Me THE SOULS WHO ARE DETAINED IN PURGATORY, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy. Let the torrents of My Blood cool down their scorching flames. All these souls are greatly loved by Me. They are making retribution to My justice. It is in your power to bring them relief. Draw all the indulgences from the treasury of My Church and offer them on their behalf. Oh, if you only knew the torments they suffer, you would continually offer for them the alms of the spirit and pay off their debt to My justice."
- DAY NINE** "Today bring to Me SOULS WHO HAVE BECOME LUKEWARM, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy. These souls wound My Heart most painfully. My soul suffered the most dreadful loathing in the Garden of Olives because of lukewarm souls. They were the reason I cried out: 'Father, take this cup away from Me, if it be Your will.' For them, the last hope of salvation is to run to My mercy."

Hour of Divine Mercy.....

To help us to obtain the Indulgence on the Feast of Divine Mercy (24th April) there will be a Holy Hour Beginning at 2:30pm, with the Divine Mercy chaplet being prayed at 3pm (the Hour Jesus died – the Hour of Mercy) with the opportunity to go to Confession too.
