Thursday, March 7, 2019 @ 10:00 a.m. CDT**

Judge Executive John Frank called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Central Time in the large conference room of the Lake Cumberland Area Development District in Russell Springs, Kentucky with 27 persons attending. Judge Frank welcomed everyone then turned the meeting over to Ms. Heather Stevenson.

Ms. Stevenson stated that there were no projects submitted for approval at this time. Ms. Stevenson went on to hand out a list of project rankings from the December meeting and mentioned that there has been a few projects that have been withdrawn from this list. On the Clean Water project list, McCreary County sewer projects listed 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 14<sup>th</sup> on the regional ranking were withdrawn. These have been withdrawn because they want to take another look at the profiles before they move forward with seeking funding. Also under the Drinking Water Project Rankings McCreary County Water District – Stearns to Smithtown Phase 2 – Water Line Replacement has been withdrawn due to acquiring other funding. City of Science Hill, listed as 15<sup>th</sup> on the regional ranking, has been withdrawn due to them wanting to take another look at that profile and consider an alternative before they move forward with that project.

Next, Judge Frank opened the floor up for Vice-Chairman Nominations. With there being no nominations Judge Phelps made a motion to keep Judge John Frank as Vice-Chairman of the LCADD Regional Water Management Planning Council. Seconded by Mayor Lawson. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Ms. Stevenson then introduced Mr. Rusty Anderson, Owner of TerraGraphics, LLC and Mr. Adam Scott (Cann-Tech), representing Green-Taylor Water District. Mr. Scott gave an overview of the type of work he and Mr. Anderson is doing for Green-Taylor Water District. Mr. Scott then turned the meeting over to Mr. Rusty Anderson. Mr. Anderson gave a very informative discussion on utilizing Water and Wastewater Data.

In other business Ms. Stevenson stated that she would be scheduling annual system visits and would be sending out some forms just letting everyone know what they can be expecting during the system visits. Ms. Stevenson also commented that the next meeting will be in June and she has asked Ms. T.K. Brown, of Kentucky Division of Water, to present. Ms. Brown will be speaking about monthly operating reports.

With there being no other business, Judge Frank thanked everyone for coming and asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion to adjourn was made by Mr. John Phelps. Seconded by Mr. Billy Bartle. All in favor. Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 10:55 a.m.
