

Empty tomb

You need:

- A paper plate, small box **or** empty 6-egg egg box
- Grey or brown paint **or** torn pieces of newspaper and glue
- Black paint or crayon or a piece of black paper
- A sheet of newspaper rolled into a ball (tape to keep in shape)
- Sticky tape or staples (if using a paper plate).

If using a **paper plate**, turn it upside down and paint it grey or brown, **or** glue pieces of torn up newspaper all over it. This will be the outside when you have finished.

Leave to dry then fold in half and cut along the fold.

Cut out a doorway in one half. Turn the other half right side up and either paint or colour this side black or stick on a piece of black paper. When dry staple or tape the two halves together round the rim.

If using an **egg box**, open the box and cut away the outer long side of both the lid and the base of the box – you keep the box and lid joined. Close up the box and check that it will stand up on this cut edge. Cut a doorway out of the lid part. For **any other box** simply cut off and use the bottom 10-15 cm and cut out a doorway in one side.

Either paint the outside grey or brown, **or** glue pieces of torn up newspaper all over it. (I like the newspaper best!)



Place your paper boulder in front of the doorway.

Use some Lego, or other play people, to act out the story of the angel rolling away the stone and Mary finding the tomb is empty then meeting Jesus in the garden.
