Jesus loves Easter egg card

You need:

Template sheet, scissors, crayons, glue and (if you have them) 2 split pin paper fasteners (you can still do it without these).

Print the template sheet onto card if possible or onto paper then stick onto thin scrap card. Cut out each piece.

Draw/colour a pattern on the cracked egg shape then carefully cut along the zig-zag crack. Colour the whole egg shape then stick the cross onto it. Write on the bottom part of the cross the name of the person you want to give the card to.

If you have split pins get an adult to poke a hole at the bottom of each half of the cracked egg (marked with a dot on the template) and in matching positions on the whole egg. Using a split pin attach each half of the cracked egg to the whole egg. Now you can open and close the egg.

If you don't have split pins just glue the two pieces of cracked egg onto the whole egg, only putting glue at the bottom, with the cracked part open so you can see the cross.

Fold the rectangle of card in half and glue one side to the back of the egg, at the bottom, so that the card will stand up.
