## James - Small Group Study Week 9

**Verses for the week:** James 4:11-12

**11**Do not speak evil against one another, brothers.<sup>d</sup> The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge. **12**There is only one lawgiver and judge, he who is able to save and to destroy. But who are you to judge your neighbor?

- 1. Who are the "brothers" he is referring to?
- 2. What is James trying to say by comparing speaking evil or judging a brother to "speaking evil against the law and judging the law?"
- 3. What is the "law" and who in these verses is the rightful judge?
