Verses for the week: Hebrews Chapter 13:20-25

Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Brothers and sisters, I urge you to bear with my word of exhortation, for in fact I have written to you quite briefly. I want you to know that our brother Timothy has been released. If he arrives soon, I will come with him to see you. Greet all your leaders and all the Lord's people. Those from Italy send you their greetings. Grace be with you all.

Questions:

1. In this closing passage, the writer of Hebrews again reminds us that it was "God ... who brought ... from the dead our Lord Jesus."

Why do you think it was, and is, so important to remember that God raised Jesus from the dead?

2. Also in this closing passage, the writer affirms the promise that God will equip believers to do His will.

How do you know the "will of God" for your life?

How are you personally "equipped" to do the "will of God" in your life?
