They covered the roof of the cabin with a tarp to keep rain and snow out.

Joe and Sarah Barnett were close family friends of Elizabeth Entriiken (of Entriiken Cabin in McGraw Park fame). Joseph Bailey was the first Bailey School Teacher and their cabin is currently located behind Bailey Propane, just across from the McGraw Memorial Park.

The cabin is on private property and public access is not permitted. In addition, access would be dangerous until we are able to restore structural integrity of the cabin.

We are still researching but we believe the cabin is from the 1870s.
