

Shelby Hudson Memorial Scholarship

In memory of Shelby Hudson, a 2003 Edmond Memorial High School graduate, a scholarship has been established and will be awarded in the amount of \$4,000 to two senior Memorial football players at the Bulldog Football Banquet each year. The recipient is chosen based on the qualities and characteristics that Shelby exhibited and stood for as a Bulldog player. These include personal *motivation* and *character*, heart and desire to excel, drive and determination to accomplish *goals*, and *perseverance* in the face of all obstacles. The recipient must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher and does not have to play football in college.

Criteria:

- · Exemplifies personal motivation and character
- · Perseverance and determination
- · Goal to attend post-secondary educational opportunities
- · 2.5 grade point average
- Recommendation form the Edmond Memorial football coaches

Deadline: November 15th

Procedures: All applications must be completed and returned to the Edmond Public Schools Foundation to be determined by the policies and procedures set forth by the Edmond Public Schools board of directors.

Notification: Scholarship recipients will be notified at the annual Memorial High School football banquet.
