Recipe of the Month — Easy Christmas Cookies

Ingredients:

- 2 cups butter
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 3 cups flour
- 1 ½ cups cornstarch
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- food coloring *optional*



Instructions:

Preheat oven to 300°F. Cream butter and vanilla with a stand mixer until fluffy.

Add flour, powdered sugar and cornstarch a little at a time mixing. If using food coloring, divide dough in two and knead in a few drops of coloring to reach desired color.

Roll into balls and place on an ungreased cookie sheet (not a non-stick cookie sheet). Flatten with a fork, or the bottom of a pretty glass. Top with sprinkles if desired. Bake for 20 minutes. Cool completely and let sit at least 24 hours before serving.
