## Compartamos nuestra Fe — sinónimo de Evangelismo

Marcos 16:15 Jesús les dijo, "vayan por todo el mundo y anuncien las buenas nuevas a toda criatura".

Hechos 13:47: Así nos lo ha mandado el Señor: "Te he puesto por luz para las naciones, a fin de que lleves mi salvación hasta los confines de la tierra."

A veces desconocemos el significado de la palabra evangelismo o lo vemos como algo complicado. ¿Que es evangelizar? ¿De que se trata? Podríamos sustituir la palabra evangelismo por compartir. Evangelismo significa anunciar el Evangelio, la historia de lo que creemos de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Entonces es tan sencillo como sustituir o reemplazar la palabra de Evangelizar por compartir. - 3. No intentes convencer a nadie acerca de Jesús al contarle tu historia, no es nuestra responsabilidad; será responsabilidad del Espíritu Santo transformar las vidas de ellos (de moldear y cambiar el corazón de ellos.)
- 4. Se ejemplo de paz, de amor, confianza, y fe a dónde quiera que vayas, así otros serán receptivos y seguidores por tu ejemplo.
- 5. Visita nuevos sitios y has nuevas amistades.
- 6. Aprende a escuchar a otros, es tu mejor herramienta para conocer sus inquietudes y necesidades.
- 7. Ora por aquellos que has conocido y deseas que se unan a la iglesia. Hazle saber a esa persona que estás orando por el o ella. La oración del justo siempre es escuchada.
- 8. Realiza actos de bondad, se creativo y amable con todos.

El compartir tu Fe, hará fortalecer tu Fe y tu vida se irá estabilizando también. No compartimos nuestra Fe porque seamos perfectos o estudiosos catedráticos de las Escrituras. Compartimos nuestra Fe para ser perfeccionados en Él y para crecer. No permitamos que el enemigo nos caye o silencie acerca de la maravillosa y nueva vida en Cristo. Cuando compartes tu Fe estás bendiciendo a otros pero estás fortaleciendo tu vida también y la confianza va a entrar en tu corazón. ## Sharing our Faith—Synonymous of Evangelism

Mark 16:15 Jesus told them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to every creature."

Acts 13:47: This is what the Lord has commanded us: "I have set you as the light unto the nations, that you may bring my salvation to the ends of the earth."

Sometimes we don't know the meaning of the word evangelism or see it as complicated. What is evangelizing? What is it about? We could substitute the word evangelism for *sharing*. Evangelism means proclaiming the Gospel, the story of what we believe of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Then it is as simple as replacing the word Evangelize with sharing. Yes, share your faith, share your story, what God has done in your life, and your story will move the hearts of others.

So how can we share Christ's message with others? Here are eight strategies you can use to share Jesus' message with others:

1. Tell others about God, in all your victories and miracles that happen to you every day, even if they are simple.

- 2. Bear witness to others of what God has done in your life, tell how your home and family has been transformed, your story.
- 3. Don't try to convince anyone about Jesus when telling your story, it's not our responsibility; it will be the responsibility of the Holy Spirit to transform their lives (to mold and change their hearts.)
- 4. Be an example of peace, love, trust, and faith wherever you go, so others will be receptive and followers by your example.
- 5. Visit new sites and make new friends.
- 6. Learn to listen to others, it is your best tool to get to know their concerns and needs.
- 7. Pray for those you have met and want to join the church. Let that person know that you are praying for them. The prayer of the righteous is always heard.
- 8. Perform acts of kindness, be creative and kind to everyone.

Sharing your faith will strengthen your faith and your life will stabilize as well. We do not share our faith because we are perfect or scholarly professors of Scripture. We share our faith to be perfected in Jesus and to grow. Let us not allow the enemy to silence us about the wonderful new life in Christ. When you share your faith, you are blessing others, but you are also strengthening your life, and confidence will enter your heart. Thoughts of insecurity and intimidation will gradually disappear.

Let us dare to tell the world about Christ and we will have more followers, (synonymous with converts) in our temples. Just as the Lord asks of us in His word.

We pray, most loving heavenly Father. Give me the strength, the security, and open opportunities to let others know what you have done in my life. Help me to be a faithful follower of love and peace wherever I go, for your son Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.




