

ROASTED GARLIC

A signature dish of Levy Restaurant Ingredients 4 whole garlic bulbs ½ cup extra virgin olive oil Water as needed

Cut off the top of the garlic bulb using a serrate knife. Mix garlic with oil, coating the garlic completely.

Place garlic cut side up in a four-inch-deep pan.

Fill pan with enough water to cover garlic halfway. Cover pan with lid.

Place in oven at 325. Cook until garlic is soft and light brown, approximately two hours.

Remove from pan and serve with your favorite bread.
