Call Process Update...

Out of 30+ things Council needs to do before forming the Call Committee, we are pretty much down to three. The big things remaining are the completion and submission of Financial and Sustainability Reports to the synod, and participating in a Congregational Retreat.

Once these last things are completed and submitted, the synod will review our documents, and advise if we are ready to put a Call Committee together. While the work that goes into the Transition Process is tedious and deliberate, it is necessary in order to call a new pastor most suited to meet Lamb of God's needs.

One area of attention unique to Lamb of God's Transition Process, is the need to better clarify the relationship between Lamb of God English and Spanish, and to clarify the working relationship between Lamb of God's Associate Pastor and Lead Pastor. This is work that was not done in the past, but necessary now in order to prepare well for a smooth transition for the next pastor.

Please be watching for more about the Congregational Retreat, and continue to hold the Transition Process in prayer. We give thanks for you and your support as we continue in this journey.

Pascua - Tiempo the Esperanza

La palabra en 1 Pedro 1:3 lee, "Bendito sea Dios, el Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que en su gran misericordia, nos hizo renacer, por la resurrección de Jesucristo, a una esperanza viva."

Entonces esforzémonos por llevar una vida recta así obtendremos la salvación que Cristo ya ganó para todos nosotros los creyentes.

En este año litúrgico Pascual hemos pasado de las tinieblas a la luz, NO ESTAMOS SOLOS, JESÚS CAMINA A NUESTRO LADO. Isaías 41:10, "Así que no temas, porque yo estoy contigo; no te angusties, porque yo soy tu Dios. Te fortaleceré y te ayudaré; te sostendré con mi diestra victoriosa."

La Esperanza nace de nuestra convicción en el Cristo resucitado. Cristo ha resucitado! ¡Verdaderamente ha resucitado! En su primera carta a los Corintios San Pablo dijo: *Y si Cristo no resucitó, el mensaje que predicamos no vale para nada, ni tampoco vale para nada la fe que ustedes tienen... Pero lo cierto es que Cristo ha resucitado.* (15, 14. 20). Easter-Time of Hope

1 Peter 1:3 reads, "Blessed be God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who in his great mercy, made us reborn, by the resurrection of Jesus Christ, to a living hope."

Easter means hope and "alive" because we believe in God's promises without hesitation nor question them, because we believe that they are true and that they will never cease to be fulfilled. We know that Christ paid the price for our faults and in Him we have the confidence and peace that we will join Him eternally, as long as we stay under His Grace, praying, studying His word and letting ourselves be carried away by His holy spirit. So let us strive to lead such a righteous life and we will obtain the salvation that Christ has already won for all of us believers.

In this Paschal liturgical year we have gone from darkness to light, WE ARE NOT ALONE, JESUS WALKS NEXT TO US. Isaiah 41:10, Do not be afraid, for I am with you; do not be distressed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will sustain you with my victorious right hand.

Hope is born of our conviction in the risen Christ. Christ is risen! Truly is risen! In his first letter to the Corinthians St. Paul said, "And if Christ was not resurrected, the message that we preach is not worth anything, nor is the faith you have worth anything... But the truth is that Christ is risen." (15, 14. 20). We are certain that the tomb is empty and that Jesus rose from the dead; and the hope we have is that one day we too will rise and live with Him for all eternity.

We pray, Lord during this Easter time give me the wisdom to follow You and put all my hope in You, lead me, fill me with Your peace and joy to live according to Your statutes. For all this I pray in the name of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

GOOD NEWS—MAY 8TH

At their recent joint meeting, Council and the Mission Steering Committee, made the decision to update the Covid Protocol as follows beginning Sunday, May 8.

- ✓ Masks will be optional
- ✓ No gloves for Pastors; but hand sanitizing/washing prior to communion
- ✓ Red ropes will remain over some pews, with Social Distancing seating
- ✓ Pews and equipment will continue to be wiped down
- ✓ Hand sanitizer will still be available.

It has been a long journey, and we give thanks that by the grace of God we have been able to navigate it well together. And we give thanks for everyone's part in helping to keep each other safe.




