Interim Pastor Notes...



Iwent home to Pennsylvania for my last uncle’s funeral a couple of weekends ago. As I was driving from the airport to my hotel, I couldn’t help but notice the color of the changing leaves across the mountains, and the crisp chill in the air. Those are some of the things I miss the most about Pennsylvania. Those are some of the things that remind me that all of God’s creation revolves around an ever-changing cycle.



These days, I am vividly reminded of that truth as Lamb of God moves through some change as it transitions between pastors. . . and as it begins to more fully clarify its relationship with Misión Hispana Luterana Cordero de Dios. . . and adjusts its worship life to meet current needs.



When it comes to preparing for a new Lead Pastor, the Council and I continue to work hard behind the scenes to get administrative things in order, so the transition is smooth under new pastoral leadership. It is slow, tedious work . . . but necessary. We still have some financial things to do, draft a Disaster Plan for the building and congregation, do a Risk Management Assessment in multiple areas, and set a date for a Congregational Mission Planning Day.

In addition, much of my work as Interim over the past few months, has been to recognize the need to more fully clarify the partnership between Lamb of God English and Spanish. Because not much work has been done in this area since the Mission formed in 2015, there are some questions and confusion. Nevertheless, it is necessary work, so the Spanish/English partnership is in a healthy place for the next Pastor. We are grateful to Bishop Suarez, Assistants to the Bishop El-Yateem and Connie Schmucker for their help in these conversations.

As this partnership evolves and grows together, here is some of what leadership has been talking about and learning. . .

- The partnership between LOG English/Spanish is a unique model for growing a mission community; with the Mission embedded in the larger ministry of Lamb of God English.
- Simply put, LOG is one congregation with both an English and Spanish expression.
- In order for ELCA mission grant monies to be available, LOG English was appointed the “fiscal agent” for the Mission by the ELCA. This means LOG English is responsible for overseeing all English/Spanish monies, for now.
- Pr. Izzy was called as Associate Pastor to Lamb of God because the Mission does not have enough members to officially organize and call a Pastor yet.
- The Mission recently elected its Mission Steering Committee, who will work closely with LOG Council in planning LOG ministry together. It is expected that some LOG ministry programs will be shared, and some programs will be “culturally specific.” (for example, both Spanish and English worship.)
- Pr. Izzy’s primary focus is to develop the Spanish Mission, and help grow the relationship between LOG Spanish and English, under the guidance of the Mission Steering Committee, and approval of LOG Council.
- It has always been the vision that LOG Spanish and English would grow its relationship together, so that more of those outside LOG doors can know the love of God in Christ Jesus. What that looks like in this time and place, and in the future, will be an ever-growing conversation with the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- The next step is for the LOG Council and Mission Steering Committee to meet and do some joint planning together; and to appoint an English and Spanish Liaison to serve on each others’ Council/Steering Committees.



And as LOG prepares for the Advent and Christmas Seasons, Council has been talking a lot about worship. After taking into consideration attendance for the past several years, a persistent virus, and the best use of the building, financial resources and those serving for each worship service. . . Council has prayerfully decided the following, FOR THIS YEAR.

- Thanksgiving worship will be celebrated Sunday, November 21st, rather than the night before Thanksgiving, THIS YEAR.
- Saturday night worship will not be celebrated in person, THIS YEAR; but online worship will be offered.
- A 2nd Sunday service will be considered, when attendance suggests it is time.
- And like last year, Christmas Day worship will be offered online only.
- Beginning All Saint's Sunday, Nov. 7th, we will reintroduce no-touch "Sharing of the Peace" with those sitting near you, as part of the Gathering.

I know this is a lot of information to take in, and I appreciate your willingness to listen. I know some may be disappointed with some things, and happy about other things. In any event, I ask that you share any thoughts and concerns with me as we look ahead to 2022-2023.

And just as the changing of leaves, and some cooler weather, remind us of the beauty of God's ever-changing good earth...may the changing of the seasons in our life together as a community of faith remind us of God's never-failing presence in the midst of all things. And may the Spirit teach us ever-changing exciting ways to serve one another, and our neighbors, in Christ.

Ingredients

6 large eggs
 2 white cake mixes
 1 cup lemon juice
 1 cup water
 1 cup vegetable oil
 Yellow food coloring (dash)
 1 – 10 oz. jar lemon curd
 2 cups fresh strawberries
 ¼ cup powdered sugar
 1 pint heavy whipping cream
 ¼ cup granulated sugar
 1 pkg. instant lemon pudding


Recipe of the Month

Strawberry Lemonade Cake

Instructions

1. Mix first 6 ingredients and bake in 3 – 8-inch pans (lightly greased and floured)
2. While cake is baking, stir lemon curd until smooth
3. In a separate bowl, make stabilized whipped cream: Whip one container of whipping cream to soft peaks. Add sugar and instant lemon pudding. Whip until mixture reaches a creamy consistency.
4. Wash and slice 2 cups of fresh strawberries. Sprinkle with ¼ cup powdered sugar and place in refrigerator.
5. After cakes bake, allow the layers to cool completely. Level, if necessary. Stack cakes: start with the first layer of cake, spread top with lemon curd, then add berries. Top off with lemon-flavored whipped cream. Add the next layers repeating the same steps until you complete the assembly.
6. Finish by adding whipped cream to the sides using frosting tips, if desired, and top off with fresh berries.

5 Beneficios del Perdón:


1. Siento Paz; sí sentirás paz, consuelo y un gran gozo en tu corazón . Alivia mis cargas.
