Next Council will take a look at demographic information for the Haines City area, review LOG Disaster Preparation, Stewardship and Strategic Plans; and continue to prepare for a Financial Audit.

It's a lot, I know. And the work is slow and tedious at times. But the Council is committed to doing the hard work of preparing for the next Pastor. And get ready. . . because very soon it will be YOUR turn to help with this important work as we look at the history of Lamb of God together, and prayerfully consider WHO God is calling Lamb of God to be into the future.

As we live in these "in-between" times between pastors, I give thanks for all of you as we tackle this prayerful work together in Jesus' name.

COVID UPDATE

Due to the extreme rise in COVID cases across Florida, the FL-Bahama Synod Council decided this month to change the Synod Assembly from face-to-face back to virtual again this year.

And as numbers are higher than they have ever been in Polk County, because the Delta Variant behaves so differently, and because some of us can't be vaccinated, including our children, Council voted at their August Meeting to follow Synod and CDC Guidelines and STAY THE COURSE with Protocols already in place. We will also TIGHTEN UP in a few areas we previously relaxed a bit.

Here's where we are right now:

Continuing to take contact information from visitors at the door

Continuing to Social Distance

Continuing to Wear Masks in Worship

Asking small groups (even if vaccinated) to wear masks again in building

Maintaining order for worship, but you may notice a few subtle changes

Asking folks to sing softly

Encouraging folks to use hand sanitizer before and after communion, etc.

Discontinuing indoor fellowship events for now

I know you are tired. . . we are all tired. But Council is trying not to have to close our doors again, and feel these things are necessary in order to keep everyone safe as promised when this all began.

No doubt things will change again as the numbers change and the science adjusts to ever-changing variables. However, this is where we are right now. We thank you for your faithful service in Christ as you take care of yourselves, your neighbors, and do your part to help ease the burden of our medical workers who are exhausted and struggling during these difficult days.

Dear Fellow Congregant:

Our Lamb of God congregation, which has been God's blessing to so many of us for so long, stands at a critically important crossroad. Because of the pandemic and the aging of our congregation, income is down dramatically. For example, bare-bones expenses have exceeded income for the past three months by about \$15,000. We have been surviving by dipping into our cash reserves, which are rapidly becoming depleted.

Despite this admittedly dire situation, I firmly believe it is God's will for us that we will survive and, yes, even prosper. Many new families have moved and will continue to move into our service area, and we are actively planning to recruit new members from that potentially fertile field. But to respond effectively to that critically important challenge takes careful planning and lots of follow-up work. Your Church Council is hard at work at that.

But such an effort takes time and money. In the meanwhile, all of us are dependent upon one another to step up and carry us through the current crisis. The Council is deeply grateful for the generous gifts it has recently received from a few among us. But much more is needed. Each member of the Church Council is examining her or his own financial situation to ascertain how she or he can help address our common need. We prayerfully ask that you do the same, whether it is through an increase in weekly giving, a lump sum gift, or both.

We are optimistic that we can step up and meet this challenge. We are called and inspired by our Lord to do just that.





Recipe of the Month Creamy Blackberry Smoothie

Ingredients

- 1 cup fresh spinach
- 1 cup coconut milk (or milk of choice)
- 1 cup blackberries
- 1/2 banana



Instructions

- 1. Add the spinach and coconut milk to the blender until smooth.
- 2. Add remaining ingredients and blend again until smooth.

NOTES

Use frozen blackberries or banana to chill the smoothie down.

TOP 5 SMOOTHIE BLENDING TIPS

- **1.** For a 2 serving smoothie, use the **2-2-3 method** for blending. That means 2 cups of <u>leafy greens</u>, 2 cups of <u>liquid</u>, and 3 cups of <u>fruit</u>. You can mix + match your leafy greens within those 2 cups as well as use a variety of fruits to come up with 3 cups.
- **2.**Blend up your leafy greens and liquid-base first. Then add your remaining fruits and blend again.



- **3.** Ditch the ice and freeze some fruits.
- **4.** Use raw natural sweeteners (sweet fruits)
- 5. Smoothie Prep.



We started a new Sunday School offering on August 29 on the Prophet Elijah and how his struggles and resilience serve




