### OUR CURRENT CHALLENGE

The truth is both our church and community continue to grow and we are simply running out of space for our kids, youth, and staff. When we were at one service, our kids space was running at 90-100% capacity in most classrooms, and we even had to turn kids away on some Sundays because the classes reached max capacity. Having to turn children away from Sunday school due to capacity restraints has filled us with grief these past several years. Since we seek to be a church community that welcomes children and partners with parents in their discipleship, providing space for them is critical. This new kids and administration building will aid and empower us to continue investing in future generations for years to come, as well as providing our staff with a space to collaborate, equip, and serve for the sake of the gospel.

#### Children's Ministry

NEED: For the adult capacity of our worship center, we need twice the square footage of childrens ministry classroom space than we currently have, which means that our kids classrooms reach their capacity long before our worship center fills up. This is the reason we've split into two services before our adult attendance and volunteers have been able to sustain a two-service rotation.

SOLUTION: Our new children's ministry building will provide over 8,000 sf of classroom space, allowing our kids' classrooms to grow in proportion to our worship center attendance.

#### Youth Ministry

NEED: We've been averaging 80 students and an extra 15 adults on Wednesday nights. While it's fun to have a crowded building, after we split the high schoolers and middle schoolers apart for the teaching time, we're completely out of space in our modular room. Additionally, splitting apart for small group discussions has been a challenge with our available space - one group recently started meeting in a storage closet!

SOLUTION: This new space will allow our middle school and high school groups to have two dedicated spaces for large group teaching and enough break-out space for our small groups to meet for discussion and prayer.







#### Homeschool Groups

NEED: We currently have two homeschool groups using our facilities with a third being added in the fall of 2022, which means that our campus is full five days a week! Some of these groups have gotten creative with classroom space, putting groups of students in hallways when the rooms are filled up.

SOLUTION: Adding this building will give these groups adequate space to conduct their classes with room to grow, allowing Grace to be a blessing to our community beyond our Sunday morning programming.

#### Office Space

NEED: Currently, we have just over 1,000 sf of office space in a mobile trailer building. This includes two offices and a shared workspace for four full-time ministry staff and 10 part-time staff, which means that some of our staff members are sharing workstations and others don't have them.

SOLUTION: The upstairs portion of this new building will provide over 3,000 sf of office space, including 5 private offices, a conference room, and an open office with space for six workstations, plus room for future expansion.

#### **Biblical Counseling**

NEED: Our Biblical Counseling ministry sees 20-25 cases per week on average, and has one counseling room available. Counselors often need to relocate their appointments to other rooms on our campus, where privacy and interruptions are a challenge.

SOLUTION: Opening this new building will allow our Biblical Counseling ministry to take over our current office space, giving them exclusive use of 3 counseling rooms and a reception lobby.



#### What is the Goal of Enduring Faithfulness?

While we do have a monetary goal, it is secondary to the main goal: 100% participation from the members of our body in making a sacrificial pledge towards this new home for our kids, students, and staff.

#### What is the process of participating in Enduring Faithfulness?

While anyone can give to this initiative at any point over the next 2 years, we are asking for our members to attend a vision gathering, engage in a season of prayer, then fill out a pledge card prior to Easter.

#### What is the purpose of the pledge card? I have never heard of that before.

The total of our pledge cards allows us to fund this project, putting us in the best possible financial position for moving forward. In the same way that we make long-term financial commitments to a mortgage or a car payment, we can do this to see God's work advance!

#### I keep hearing about "Commitment Night." What is that?

On April 2, we will be coming together for a very special night of filling out our pledge cards and celebrating. Our hope is that every member of Grace Bible joins us.

#### I have heard of "First Fruits" Sunday? How does that work?

On Sunday, April 24, we are holding a special Sunday of "First Fruits" giving. In the Bible, the people of God brought the first of their fields to God in an act of worship. Our hope is that our members will target 10% of their overall pledge for this special offering to help us launch our project.

#### How can I give stocks or other appreciated assets?

#### How will the church pay for the total project?

Obviously, the goal of 3 million is not going to cover the total cost of this project, so the elders have discussed this and agreed that they are comfortable securing a short-term loan for the remaining balance. The hope is that the loan can be paid off in 5 years or less through allocating 20% of the general budget to debt reduction, and continuing to receive designated building funds.
