### Dress Code (K-5<sup>th</sup>)

#### Monday – Thursday

On Monday through Thursday, the attire for students will consist of casual clothing such as collared shirts, khakis, etc...

#### Jean Fridays

On Fridays, students are free to dress comfortably in t-shirts and jeans.

#### Field Trips

During field trips, students are allowed to wear jeans—unless advised otherwise by their teacher—and our official Red BCS T-Shirt! (Red BCS T-Shirts can be purchased at the school office.)

#### Acceptable

- Shirts – *Long or Short Sleeve, Collared, Button-Down, or Turtleneck (Solid Color or BCS Apparel)*
- Sweaters or Sweater Vests (**Solid Color or BCS Apparel**)
- Pants – *Khakis or Slacks*
- Khaki Shorts (**Mid-Thigh in Length**)
- Skirts, Dresses, or Jumpers (**Mid-Thigh in Length, Solid or Plaid**)
- Leggings or Tights (**Must be paired with a skirt, dress, or jumper that is mid-thigh in length.**)
- Shoes (**Must be Closed-Toed**)
- [Jean Fridays] Shirts or Tees
- [Jean Fridays] Jeans
- [Jean Fridays] Jean Shorts

#### Unacceptable

- Shirts that contain images or wording that would potentially be offensive, immoral, or inappropriate.
- Shirts that do not provide adequate coverage of the body such as tank tops, spaghetti straps, etc.
- Pants/Jeans that have distressed marks, rips, or holes; nor can they be baggy or overly tight
- Shorts that have distressed marks, rips, or holes; nor can they be baggy or overly tight
- Hats or hoods inside of the building
- Shorts, skirts, dresses, or jumpers that are shorter than mid-thigh length; with or without leggings or tights
- Open-toed shoes such as flip-flops, sandals, athletic slides, etc.
- Basketball shorts, sweatpants, or yoga pants
- Neon colored clothing
