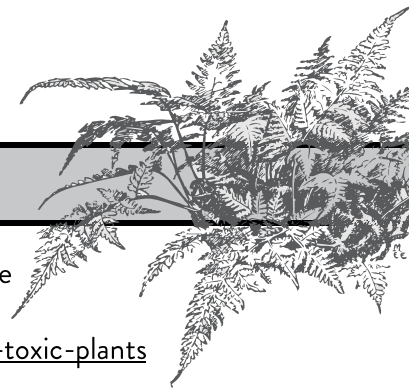

POINSETTIAS

The Facts:

This holiday plant is NOT poisonous, nor is it edible. A 50 lb. child would have to eat over 500 leaves to exceed levels found to be toxic. Out of 22,793 cases of ingestion, no significant toxicity has been found by the American Association of Poison Control Centers. Furthermore, the American Veterinary Medical Association does NOT include poinsettias in its list of plants that can be a threat to animals.
