



George & Joan White Howell Environmental Education Scholarship Application

The George and Joan White Howell Environmental Education Scholarship is a \$1,000 science scholarship, administered through the Lake Area Foundation, available to a freshman entering Campbellsville University for the 2019-2020 scholastic year. Students who graduate from a Ky. high school in Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, Green, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, Taylor or Wayne counties will be given first consideration. Another \$1,000 is available annually to the same freshman student pursuing a science degree who is willing to help with research at Clay Hill Memorial Forest for a minimum of 70 hours per semester during the academic year. Students applying for this scholarship must meet the following requirements:

1. Eligible for and receiving CU scholarship;
2. Pursuing Science Degree;
3. High School GPA 3.5. and maintain CU GPA 3.0;
4. ACT Score of 24 or above on the science portion of the exam;
5. All students applying shall submit an essay of not less than 200 words describing interest in the environment and how they hope to utilize their degree to promote Earth stewardship.
