You are important to the smooth operation of your club and to the planning and carrying out of activities resulting in the growth and stature of your club. I ask you to shoulder your full share of the load and keep yourselves well informed concerning all Soroptimist matters on club, regional, federation and international levels. I give each of you , representing your votes and directives that you will exercise wisely and well in the best interest of your club. Treasurer: You have been elected treasurer of your club. Your duties consist of receiving all funds of the club, depositing them into the bank, preparing and signing all checks and making all remittances as required by regional and federation bylaws and paying authorized bills in the manner provided in your club bylaws. It is most important that you keep good books and records and have them available for audit at the proper time. Corresponding Secretary: You have been elected as corresponding secretary of your club. Your duties shall be to send out notices and carry on such correspondence as does not properly belong to other officers. Your represents a calendar for reminding you to mail all notices and other correspondence that you will be required to handle. Recording Secretary: You have been elected recording secretary of your club. Your duties are to be present at business and board meetings and to keep a good and careful record of all proceedings. You will be keeping permanent records for all time and you must be careful to record all matters required under rules of good parliamentary procedure. Minutes of the business meetings and any recommendations from the board will be submitted by you to the club. Further, you will maintain a roll of membership for your club. Your , represent a notebook for you to record the many notations you will be making of the club proceedings for its permanent records. 2nd Vice President: You have been elected as second vice president of your club and you must be ever ready to step into the shoes of the president whenever she and the first vice president are absent, or whenever called upon to do so. You should be ever ready to perform any other duties as required of you by the president, and to bee aware of all club programs.
