Nicene Creed 325 AD

Genesis 1:26–27 “26 Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness. They will rule the fish of the sea, the birds of the sky, the livestock, all the earth, and the creatures that crawl on the earth. 27 So God created man in His own image; He created him in the image of God; He created them male and female.”

Ephesians 3:14–15 “14 For this reason I kneel before the Father 15 from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named.”
