1. This chart represents the phases of reopening of our state and local area based on guidelines given by the CDC.
2. Our church is following this phasing in the various areas of ministry as shown.
3. It is our desire to regather gradually, safely, maintaining our strong online presence, and with flexibility as circumstances change.
4. We strongly recommend all those considered vulnerable population (VP) by the CDC (shown below) to remain home until phase 3 of reopening.
5. Limited seating is available in our services that will begin meeting in person once again on May 17th, so we ask that you will register online at fellowship301.org/regathering so that we can provide adequate accommodations that are safe and orderly.
6. PHASE TIMING:
 - The time of each phase is based on the recommendations of our local and state authorities, anticipating 2-3 weeks for each phase.
7. Worship Service Considerations:
 - In phase 1, we will open the auditorium with strict social distancing measures and limited seating of 100 or less. There will be three services at 8, 9:30, and 11am plus additional services as needed; Connection Center will be used as needed for overflow seating.
 - In phase 2, we will increase the number of seats available in the auditorium and bring back LifeGroups to regular meeting times and capacity
 - In phase 3, we will move to regular seating in the auditorium and bring back nursery and kids programming as well.
